AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO CONTRACT MA-080-21010921 FOR PORTLAND CEMENT CONCRETE MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR SERVICES

This AMENDMENT is made and entered into as of the date fully executed by and between the County of Orange, a political subdivision of the State of California, and the Orange County Flood Control District, a body corporate and politic ("County"), and Hardy & Harper, Inc., with a place of business at 32 Rancho Circle, Lake Forest, CA 92630 ("Contractor"), with County and Contractor sometimes individually referred to as "Party" or collectively referred to as "Parties".

RECITALS

WHEREAS, County and Contractor entered into Master Contract MA-080-21010921, effective March 2, 2021, through March 1, 2024, in the Total Contract Amount not-to-exceed \$6,000,000; and

WHEREAS, the Parties now desire to renew Contract for one (1) year effective March 2, 2024 through and including March 1, 2025 with a Total Contract Amount of \$2,000,000.00; and,

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties agree as follows:

AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT ARTICLES

1. Article 2 of the Contract shall be amended to including the following:

Contract shall be renewed for one (1) year from March 2, 2024 through and including March 1, 2025, unless otherwise terminated as provided herein.

2. Article 4 of the Contract shall be amended to include the following:

The first renewal term for the Aggregate Contract with Bitech Construction Company Inc., Hardy & Harper, Inc., and Gentry General Engineering, Inc. shall have a Total Aggregate Contract Amount not to exceed \$2,000,000.00.

- 3. Article 27 of the Contract shall be amended to read in its entirety as follows:
 - **27. Notices:** Any and all notices, requests demands and other communications contemplated, called for, permitted, or required to be given hereunder shall be in writing with a copy provided to the assigned DPA, except through the course of the parties' project managers' routine exchange of information and cooperation during the terms of the work and services. Any written communications shall be deemed to have been duly given upon actual in-person delivery, if delivery is by direct hand, or upon delivery on the actual day of receipt or no greater than four (4) calendar days after being mailed by US certified or registered mail, return receipt requested, postage prepaid, whichever occurs first. The date of mailing shall count as the first day. All communications shall be addressed to the appropriate party at the address stated herein or such other address as the parties hereto may designate by written notice from time to time in the manner aforesaid.
