Background:

Across the state of California, 25 Community Choice Aggregation (CCA) programs serve more than 11 million customers. CCAs help advance climate goals and provide residents and businesses more competitive options for power. While the Orange County Power Authority has significant operation issues, another CCA could serve the residents of the unincorporated areas of the County. At least three Orange County cities have expressed interested in joining another CCA. I recommend that the County explore CCA programs that can effectively serve the residents of the unincorporated areas.

Recommended Action:

1. Direct the County Executive Officer to research Community Choice Aggregation (CCA) programs, including but not limited to San Diego Community Power, and return to the Board with information pertaining to CCAs for the County to consider joining.
