AMENDMENT No. 1 TO AGREEMENT NUMBER MA-074-15011958 FOR ARMORED CAR SERVICES CONTRACT

WHEREAS, County and Contractor entered into Contract number MA-074-15011958, hereinafter referred to as ("Contract"), for Armored Car Services, effective August 1, 2015 through and including July 31, 2018;

WHEREAS, the Parties now desirous to amend the Contract to renew contract for one two-year term; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual obligations set forth herein, both County and Contractor agree to amend the Contract as follows:

ARTICLES

- 1. Contract MA-074-15011958 is extended for one two-year term, commencing on August 1, 2018 through and including July 31, 2020 in an amount not to exceed \$420,000
- 2. This Amendment modifies the Original Contract only as expressly set forth above. This Amendment does not modify, after or amend the Contract in any other way whatsoever. Except as otherwise expressly set forth herein, all terms and conditions, amendments/modifications are incorporated by this reference and shall remain unchanged
