

**Amendment No. Three to  
 MA-017-22011093

 Southwest Strategies, LLC  
 For  
 Spent Fuel Solutions (SFS) Management Services at San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station  
 (SONGS)**

This AMENDMENT NUMBER THREE to Contract MA-017-22011093 (hereinafter referred to as "Amendment No. Three") is made and entered into as of the date fully executed by and between the County of Orange, a political subdivision of the State of California ("County") and Southwest Strategies, LLC, ("Contractor"), with County and Contractor sometimes individually referred to as "Party" or collectively referred to as "Parties".

**Recitals**

WHEREAS, County and Contractor entered into Contract MA-017-22011093 for Action for Spent Fuel Solutions Now (ASFSN) Management Services at San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station (SONGS), effective March 22, 2022, through March 21, 2023, in the Not-to-Exceed Amount of \$100,000, ("Contract"); and,

WHEREAS, on March 9, 2023, Parties executed Amendment Number One to renew the Contract for an additional one-year term, effective March 22, 2023, through March 21, 2024, in the amount of \$100,000, for a cumulative total amount Not-to-Exceed \$200,000; and,

WHEREAS, on March 22, 2024, Parties executed Amendment Number Two to renew the Contract for two additional years, effective March 22, 2024, through March 21, 2026, in the amount of \$100,000 per year, with a new total cumulative Not-to-Exceed amount of \$400,000; and,

WHEREAS, the Parties now desire to amend the contract title to reflect the coalition name change from Action for Spent Fuel Solutions Now (ASFSN) to Spent Fuel Solutions (SFS), and to renew the Contract for one (1) additional year, effective March 22, 2026, through March 21, 2027, with a new cumulative Not-to-Exceed Amount of \$500,000; and,

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties agree as follows:

1. The Contract title shall be amended to read as follows:

Spent Fuel Solutions (SFS) Management Services at San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station (SONGS)

2. Spent Fuel Solutions (SFS) shall replace Action for Spent Fuel Solutions Now (ASFSN) wherever referenced within the Contract.

3. Paragraph 2.0 of the Contract shall be amended to read as follows:

Term of Contract: This Contract shall commence on March 22, 2022, and continue through March 21, 2027, unless otherwise terminated by County. County does not have to give a reason if it elects not to renew.

4. Paragraph A of Attachment B, Compensation for Services, shall be amended to read as follows:

Compensation: In accordance with the provisions of the General and Additional Terms and Conditions, and Scope of Work herein, Contractor will be paid \$8,333.33 monthly, for a maximum total contract amount not to exceed \$500,000 under this Contract.

Contractor agrees to accept the specified compensation as set forth in this Contract as full remuneration for performing all services and furnishing all staffing and materials required, for any reasonably unforeseen difficulties which may arise or be encountered in the execution of the services until acceptance, for risks connected with the services, and for performance by Contractor of all its duties and obligations hereunder. County has no obligation to pay any sum in excess of the total Contract amount unless authorized by an amendment in accordance with paragraphs C and P of the Contract's General Terms and Conditions.

5. All other terms and conditions in this Contract shall remain unchanged and with full force and effect.



IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Parties hereto have executed this Amendment on the date first above written.
