WHEREAS, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR renewed the ORIGINAL CONTRACT on April 24, 2018 as Contract number MA-060-18011492 for a one-year term of April 26, 2018 through and including April 25, 2019 (hereinafter "AMENDMENT NUMBER ONE"

WHEREAS, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR renewed the ORIGINAL CONTRACT on April 24, 2019 as Contract number MA-060-19011104 for a one year tenn of April 26, 2019 through and including April 25, 2020 (hereinafter "AMENDMENT NUMBER TWO);

WHEREAS, COUNTY desires to renew the ORIGINAL CONTRACT as Contract number MA 060 20010909 for a one year term of April 26, 2020 through and including April 25, 2021, and the CONTRACTOR has agreed to provide those services at the rates set forth in the ORJGINAL CONTRACT, as amended; and

### RECITALS

WHEREAS, the County of Merced, has issued a Master Price Agreement (FOCUS) Contract No. 2021360, now in effect from November 16, 2021, through and including November 15, 2024; and

WHEREAS, County and Contractor desire to enter into a Subordinate Contract for telecommunication technology goods and services in connection with the Fast Open Contracts Utilization Services (FOCUS) Contract No. 2021360; and

WHEREAS, Contractor is willing to provide the services specified in this Subordinate Contract to County of Orange, Sheriff-Coroner Department; and

WHEREAS, COUNTY agrees to pay Contractor based on the pricing specified in this Subordinate Contract; and

WHEREAS, the County Board of Supervisors has authorized the Purchasing Agent or designee to enter into a Contract for telecommunications technology goods and services with the Contractor;

#### NOW, THEREFORE, the parties mutually agree:

- 1. Scope of Work: This Subordinate Contract specifies the terms and conditions by which Sheriff-Coroner Department will procure services in connection with the Fast Open Contracts Utilization Services (FOCUS) from the Contractor, hereinafter referred to as "Services" as more fully detailed in Attachment A, Scope of Work/Pricing.
- 2. Precedence: In the event of a conflict between the terms and conditions in this Contract and terms and conditions in the Attachments, the conflict shall be resolved by giving precedence first to the terms and conditions of this Contract, and then the terms and conditions of Attachment B, and then the terms and conditions of Attachment A.
- 3. Term of Contract: This Contract shall commence upon execution of all necessary signatures, and shall be effective through and including November 15, 2024, unless otherwise terminated

by County. Each renewal of this Contract may require approval by the County Board of Supervisors. The County does not have to give a reason if it elects not to renew.

- 4. Compensation & Payment: Contractor agrees to provide services in connection with the Fast Open Contracts Utilization Services (FOCUS) as set forth in Attachment A, Scope of Work/Pricing, at the fixed discounted rates specified in the FOCUS Contract No. 2021360. Compensation shall not exceed the amount of \$15,000,000 for the first contract term.
- 5. Invoicing: Vendor shall reference Contract Number MA-060-22010329 on all invoices. Payment will be net 30 days after receipt of an invoice in a format acceptable to the County of Orange and verified and approved by the agency/department and subject to routine processing requirements. The responsibility for providing an acceptable invoice rests with the contractor.

In the event of any legal action to enforce or interpret this Contract, the sole and exclusive venue shall be a court of competent jurisdiction located in Orange County, California, and the parties hereto agree to and do hereby submit to the jurisdiction of such court, notwithstanding Code of Civil Procedure Section 394. Furthermore, the parties specifically agree to waive any and all rights to request that an action be transferred for trial to another county.
- 7. Notices: Any and all notices permitted or required to be given hereunder shall be deemed duly given (1) upon actual delivery, if delivery is by hand; or (2) upon delivery by the United States mail if delivery is by postage paid registered or certified return receipt requested mail. Each such notice shall be sent to the respective Party at the address indicated below or to any other address as the respective Parties may designate from time to time.

8. Insurance Provisions: Prior to the provision of services under this Contract, the Contractor agrees to purchase all required insurance at Contractor's expense, including all endorsements required herein, necessary to satisfy the County that the insurance provisions of this Contract have been complied with. Contractor agrees to keep such insurance coverage, Certificates of Insurance, and endorsements on deposit with the County during the entire term of this Contract. In addition, all subcontractors performing work on behalf of Contractor pursuant to this Contract shall obtain insurance subject to the same terms and conditions as set forth herein for Contractor.

Contractor shall ensure that all subcontractors performing work on behalf of Contractor pursuant to this Contract shall be covered under Contractor's insurance as an Additional Insured or maintain insurance subject to the same terms and conditions as set forth herein for Contractor. Contractor shall not allow subcontractors to work if subcontractors have less than the level of coverage required by County from Contractor under this Contract. It is the obligation of Contractor to provide notice of the insurance requirements to every subcontractor and to receive proof of insurance prior to allowing any subcontractor to begin work. Such proof of insurance must be maintained by Contractor through the entirety of this Contract for inspection by County representative(s) at any reasonable time.

All self-insured retentions (SIRs) shall be clearly stated on the Certificate of Insurance. Any self-insured retention (SIR) in an amount in excess of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) shall specifically be approved by the County's Risk Manager, or designee, upon review of Contractor's current audited financial report. If Contractor's SIR is approved, Contractor, in addition to, and without limitation of, any other indemnity provision(s) in this Contract, agrees to all of the following:

- In addition to the duty to indemnify and hold the County harmless against any and all liability, claim, demand or suit resulting from Contractor's, its agents, employee's or subcontractor's performance of this Contract, Contractor shall defend the County at its sole cost and expense with counsel approved by Board of Supervisors against same; and
- 2) Contractor's duty to defend, as stated above, shall be absolute and irrespective of any duty to indemnify or hold harmless; and
- 3) The provisions of California Civil Code Section 2860 shall apply to any and all actions to which the duty to defend stated above applies, and the Contractor's SIR provision shall be interpreted as though the Contractor was an insurer and the County was the insured.

If the Contractor fails to maintain insurance acceptable to the County for the full term of this Contract, the County may terminate this Contract.

### Qualified Insurer

The policy or policies of insurance must be issued by an insurer with a minimum rating of A-(Secure A.M. Best's Rating) and VIII (Financial Size Category as determined by the most current edition of the Best's Key Rating Guide/Property-Casualty/United States or ambest.com). It is preferred, but not mandatory, that the insurer be licensed to do business in the state of California (California Admitted Carrier). If the insurance carrier does not have an A.M. Best Rating of A-/VIII, the CEO/Office of Risk Management retains the right to approve or reject a carrier after a review of the contractory of the performance and financial ratings.

#### Required Coverage Forms

The Commercial General Liability coverage shall be written on Insurance Services Office (ISO) form CG 00 01, or a substitute form providing liability coverage at least as broad.

The Business Auto Liability coverage shall be written on ISO form CA 00 01, CA 00 05, CA 0012, CA 00 20, or a substitute form providing coverage at least as broad.

#### **Required Endorsements**

The Commercial General Liability policy shall contain the following endorsements, which shall accompany the Certificate of Insurance:

- 1) An Additional Insured endorsement using ISO form CG 20 26 04 13 or a form at least as broad naming the *County of Orange its elected and appointed officials, officers, agents and employees* as Additional Insured's, or provide blanket coverage, which will state *AS REQUIRED BY WRITTEN CONTRACT*..
- 2) A primary non-contributing endorsement using ISO form CG 20 01 04 13, or a form at least as broad evidencing that the Contractor's insurance is primary and any insurance or self-insurance maintained by the County of Orange shall be excess and non-contributing.
- 3) The Workers' Compensation policy shall contain a waiver of subrogation endorsement waiving all rights of subrogation against the *County of Orange, its elected and appointed*

officials, officers, agents and employees or provide blanket coverage, which will state AS REQUIRED BY WRITTEN CONTRACT.

All insurance policies required by this Contract shall waive all rights of subrogation against the County of Orange, its elected and appointed officials, officers, agents and employees when acting within the scope of their appointment or employment.

Contractor shall notify County in writing within thirty (30) days of any policy cancellation and ten (10) days for non-payment of premium and provide a copy of the cancellation notice to County. Failure to provide written notice of cancellation may constitute a material breach of the Contract, upon which the County may suspend or terminate this Contract.

If Contractor's Technology Errors & Omissions are "Claims-Made" policy(ies), Contractor shall agree to maintain coverage for two (2) years following the completion of the Contract.

The Commercial General Liability policy shall contain a severability of interest's clause also known as a "separation of insured's" clause (standard in the ISO CG 0001 policy).

Insurance certificates should be forwarded to the agency/department address listed on the solicitation.

If the Contractor fails to provide the insurance certificates and endorsements within seven (7) days of notification by CEO/Purchasing or the agency/department purchasing division, award may be made to the next qualified vendor.

County expressly retains the right to require Contractor to increase or decrease insurance of any of the above insurance types throughout the term of this Contract. Any increase or decrease in insurance will be as deemed by County of Orange Risk Manager as appropriate to adequately protect County.

County shall notify Contractor in writing of changes in the insurance requirements. If Contractor does not deposit copies of acceptable Certificates of Insurance and endorsements with County incorporating such changes within thirty (30) days of receipt of such notice, this Contract may be in breach without further notice to Contractor, and County shall be entitled to all legal remedies.

The procuring of such required policy or policies of insurance shall not be construed to limit Contractor's liability hereunder nor to fulfill the indemnification provisions and requirements of this Contract, nor act in any way to reduce the policy coverage and limits available from the insurer.
