WHEREAS, the week of April 6 – 12, 2026, has been designated as **National Public Health Week**; and

WHEREAS, National Public Health Week provides an opportunity to recognize the dedicated professionals across numerous academic, public, community and private settings who work tirelessly to protect and promote the health and well-being of all who live, work, travel, and play in Orange County; and

WHEREAS, the theme for National Public Health Week 2026 is **“Ready. Set. Action!”**, emphasizing the importance of proactive steps toward a healthier future; and

WHEREAS, The Orange County Board of Supervisors is committed to protecting the health of Orange County’s residents, including limiting the use of herbicide in waterways; and

WHEREAS, public health professionals play vital roles in building healthier and safer communities, advancing health education, preventing disease, and responding to emerging health challenges while addressing disparities and fostering resilience.

WHEREAS, public health teams led community awareness and prevention efforts, partnered with private and public institutions on system-level initiatives, supported population health priorities, and partnered with local academic institutions to train and host the next generation of public health professionals; and

WHEREAS, the OC Health Care Agency celebrates the work of the Public Health Services staff and recognizes the essential partnerships across sectors, community organizations, healthcare providers, educators, businesses, and Federal, State and local County agencies—that work together to develop and implement solutions to complex health challenges; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the **Orange County Board of Supervisors** does hereby proclaim the week of April 6 – 12, 2026, as **National Public Health Week in Orange County, California**, with the theme **“Ready. Set.
