11	hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY," and Access California Services, a California non-profit		
12	corporation hereinafter referred to as "CONTRACTOR." This Amendment shall be administered		
13	by the County of Orange Social Services Agency, hereinafter referred to as "ADMINISTRATOR."

15	WITNESSETH:

17	WHEREAS, on August 22, 2017, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR entered into an		
18	Agreement for the provision of Refugee Social Services and Refugee Health Services, for the		
19	period of October 1, 2017 through September 30, 2020; and		
20	WHEREAS, COUNTY agrees to increase funding for the provision of additional Refugee		
21	Social Services to clients referred to CONTRACTOR by COUNTY; and		
22	WHEREAS, CONTRACTOR agrees to such extension and to continue to provide such		
23	services under the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement;		
24	ACCORDINGLY, THE PARTIES AGREED AS FOLLOWS:		
25	1. Subparagraph 19.1 of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:		
26	"19.1 <u>Maximum Contractual Obligation</u>		
27	The maximum obligation of COUNTY under this Agreement shall not exceed the amount of		
28	\$1,008,0331,079,463: the amount of \$607,150 for October 1, 2017 through September 30, 2018;		

the amount of \$\frac{175,000}{246,430} for October 1, 2018 through September 30, 2019; and the amount 1 of \$225,883 for October 1, 2019 through September 30, 2020, or actual allowable costs, whichever 2 3 is less.
