

**AMENDMENT #1  
TO MA-012-22011314  
FOR  
ON-CALL ENVIRONMENTAL CLEAN-UP SERVICES**

This Amendment is made and entered into as of the date fully executed by and between the County of Orange, a political subdivision of the State of California, (“County”) and Patriot Environmental Services, Inc., a California corporation with a place of business at 1250 E 23rd St, Signal Hill, CA 90755 (“Contractor”), with County and Contractor sometimes individually referred to as “Party” or collectively referred to as “Parties.”

**RECITALS**

WHEREAS, County and Contractor entered into Subordinate Contract MA-012-22011314 for On-Call Environmental Clean-Up Services, effective March 27, 2022 through March 26, 2025, in the amount of \$200,000.00/Per Year “Contract”; and

WHEREAS, County now desires to increase Contract to an aggregate not to exceed amount of \$500,000.00/Per Year, and to revise Contract Articles, Section 3, Aggregate Contract, Section 4, Notices, and Section 2(A) of Attachment A (Payment/Compensation); and

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties agree as follows:

**AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT ARTICLES**

1. Article 3 “Aggregate Contract” shall be amended and replaced in its entirety with the following:
  - A. **Aggregate Contract:** This is an Aggregate Contract with Hunter Consulting, Inc. dba HCI Environmental & Engineering Service, and Patriot Environmental Services, Inc. with Aggregate Contract Amount not to exceed Five Hundred Thousand Dollars Per Year (\$500,000.00/Per Year)
2. Article 4 “Notices” shall be amended and replaced in its entirety with the following:
  4. **Notices:** Any and all notices, requests demands and other communications contemplated, called for, permitted, or required to be given hereunder shall be in writing with a copy provided to the assigned Deputy Purchasing Agent (DPA), except through the course of the parties’ project managers’ routine exchange of information and cooperation during the terms of the work and services. Any written communications shall be deemed to have been duly given upon actual in-person delivery, if delivery is by direct hand, or upon delivery on the actual day of receipt or no greater than four (4) calendar days after being mailed by US certified or registered mail, return receipt requested, postage prepaid, whichever occurs first. The date of mailing shall count as the first day. All communications shall be addressed to the appropriate party at the address stated herein or such other address as the parties hereto may designate by written notice from time to time in the manner aforesaid.
