This AMENDMENT NUMBER ~~ONE~~ TWO to Contract Number MA-060-20010085 (hereinafter "AMENDMENT NUMBER ~~ONE~~ TWO") between the County of Orange, a political subdivision of the State of California, operating through its Sheriff-Coroner Department (hereinafter "COUNTY"), and Stancil Corporation (hereinafter referred to as "CONTRACTOR") with a place of business at 8931 Research Drive, Irvine, CA 92618~~2644 South Croddy Way, Santa Ana, CA 92704~~ is made and entered upon execution of all necessary signatures.

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR executed a Contract for SLR-Stancil Voice Logging Recorders and NAS Server Maintenance Services on October 9, 2019, for a two (2) year term of October 9, 2019 through and including October 8, 2021, in an amount not to exceed \$17,284 renewable for three (3) additional one (1) year terms (hereinafter "ORIGINAL CONTRACT");

WHEREAS, COUNTY ~~and CONTRACTOR desires to~~ renewed the ORIGINAL CONTRACT ~~on September 14, 2021,~~ for a one (1) year term of October 9, 2021 through and including October 8, 2022 in an amount not to exceed \$9,384; as well as amended ATTACHMENT B, Compensation and Pricing Provisions, Section 3. Pricing in its entirety ~~(hereinafter "AMENDMENT NUMBER ONE"); and the CONTRACTOR has agreed to continue to provide those services at the rates set forth in this AMENDMENT NUMBER ONE;~~

~~WHEREAS, COUNTY desires to renew the ORIGINAL CONTRACT for a one (1) year term of October 9, 2022 through and including October 8, 2023 in an amount not to exceed \$9,538; as well as amend ATTACHMENT B, Compensation and Pricing Provisions, Section 3. Pricing in its entirety and the CONTRACTOR has agreed to continue to provide those services at the rates set forth in this AMENDMENT NUMBER TWO;~~

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual obligations set forth herein, both COUNTY and CONTRACTOR agree as follows:

ARTICLES

- a. Additional Terms and Conditions, Section Term of Contract, of the ORIGINAL CONTRACT is amended to read in its entirety as follows:

2. Term of Contract:

This Contract shall commence upon execution of all necessary signatures, and continue in effect from 10/9/19 through and including 10/8/20~~2~~, unless otherwise terminated by COUNTY.

- b. Additional Terms and Conditions, Section 3 – Renewals, of the ORIGINAL CONTRACT is amended in its entirety as follows:

3. Renewal: This Contract may be renewed by mutual written agreement of both parties for ~~one (1) two (2)~~ additional one (1) year terms. The County does not have to give reason if it elects not to renew. Renewal periods may be subject to approval by the County of Orange Board of Supervisors.

- c. Attachment B, Compensation and Pricing Provisions, Section 3. Pricing is amended in its entirety to read as follows:
