

Sole Source Request Form Instruction Sheet

COUNTY POLICY ON SOLE SOURCE CONTRACTS:

It is the policy of the County of Orange to solicit competitive bids and proposals for its procurement requirements. Per the Contract Policy Manual, a sole source procurement shall not be used unless there is clear and convincing evidence that only one source exists to fulfill the County's requirements, CPM section 4.5. All sole source purchases requiring Board of Supervisors approval shall be justified as meeting the sole source standard in the Agenda Staff Report. The Agenda Staff Report shall clearly state that it is a sole source procurement. The Sole Source Justification, as described below, shall be attached within the Agenda Staff Report (CPM, Section 4.5)

SECTION I – INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING THE ATTACHED FORM (To be completed by the department's end-user, Program Manager, or Subject Matter Expert)

- 1. Formal justification is required for sole source procurements when competitive bid guidelines require pricing from competing firms.
- 2. A written justification will be prepared by the department and approved by the department head or designee.
- 3. Prior to execution of a contract, the County Procurement Officer or designee shall approve ALL sole source requests for commodities that exceed \$250,000 annually, services exceeding \$75,000 annually and all Board contracts despite the amount. Board approval is required for all sole source contracts for commodities that exceed \$250,000 annually and services exceeding \$75,000 annually or a two (2) year consecutive term, regardless of the contract amount. Any amendments to Board approved sole source contracts require a new sole source form.
- 4. If vendor is a retired, former Orange County employee, CEO Human Resource Services shall approve the sole source request, regardless of the sole source amount.
- 5. Valid sole source requests will contain strong technological and/or programmatic justifications. Requests will explain how it is a sole source purchase, provide a clear and convincing justification and detail the purchasing history (who, what, when, how and where).
- 6. Sole source procurements may be approved based upon emergency situations in which there is not adequate time for competitive bidding.
- 7. Sole source requests for Human Service contracts will be guided by the regulations of the funding source.
- 8. Each question in Section II of this form must be answered in detail and the form signed by the department head with concurrence of the Deputy Purchasing Agent.
- 9. All sole source request forms must be entered into the County's online bidding system along with its supporting documentation.
- 10. The Deputy Purchasing Agent (DPA) shall retain a copy of the justification/approval as part of the contract file.
- 11. Request for Solicitation Exemption (For purchases with special circumstances, and/or when it is determined to be in the best interest of the County) check the Solicitation Exemption box and complete additional question no 8.

 This is a human service contract for the provision of housing search assistance, unit identification, financial assistance and housing stabilization services in support of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development's (HUD) Emergency Housing Voucher (EHV) Program.

On March 11, 2021, President Biden signed the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA) into law, which provides over \$1.9 trillion in relief to address the continue impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on the economy, public health, State and local governments, individuals and businesses. Section 3202 of the ARPA appropriates \$5 billion for new incremental Emergency Housing Vouchers (EHVs), the renewal of those EHVs, and fees for the cost of administering the EHVs and other eligible expenses defined by notice PIH 2021-15 (HA). Through this new EHV Program, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) is providing 70,000 housing choice vouchers to local Public Housing Authorities (PHAs) to assist individuals and families who are experiencing homelessness, at risk of homelessness, fleeing or attempting to flee domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, stalking, or human trafficking, or were recently homeless or have a high risk of housing stability.

The Orange County Housing Authority (OCHA) has received a total of 557 EHVs. OCHA is working in partnership with the County Executive Office (CEO), and Human Options to make the EHV Program available to individuals and families who are fleeing or attempting to flee domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, stalking, or human trafficking. This includes providing individuals and families who are issued an EHV with housing search assistance to identify a rental unit that accepts EHVs and providing housing stabilization services for a minimum of 12 months to assist the household in achieving housing stability.

Contracting with Human Options will support OCHA in meeting leasing up deadlines and increase the likelihood of receiving additional bonus funding for EHV Program. Additionally, it would support the County of Orange's development of a comprehensive System of Care that effectively addresses the homelessness of a very vulnerable subpopulation in Orange County. Many victims of domestic violence face higher barriers to safety and housing stabilization due to serious health and legal issues, trauma and lack of income development. The EHV program will provide lasting economic support, ongoing safety and housing stability to our highest need survivors who would not gain stability otherwise.

Through this contract Human Options will ensure households will be supported with vouchers provided through the EHV program, receive wraparound services and additional resources to leverage the EHV program.

3. Explain why the recommended vendor is the only one capable of providing the required services and/or commodities. How did you determine this to be a sole source and what specific steps did you take? Human Options has been designated as the lead agency for three distinguished domestic violence service organizations in Orange County, namely Human Options, Laura's House, and Women's Transitional Living Center, Inc. (WTLC) and will act as the fiscal agent for these three organizations. Human Options will also work with Families Forward to support in the unit identification process and leveraging of landlord network to identify appropriate rental housing for the EHV participants. These organizations will quickly provide specialized support services to survivors of domestic violence who are issued EHV program from OCHA, collectively serving the different Service Planning Areas of Orange County and bring expertise in the unit identification and leasing activities. The four organizations will coordinate and prioritize those who are fleeing domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, stalking or human trafficking, have active or previous enrollment within existing programs and low income or lack of income potential.

Human Options has proposed a comprehensive service delivery plan that will provide trauma-informed and survivor-centered support to those who are in highest need for EHVs. Specialized services will target survivor needs and maximize resource utilization to assist with legal issues, trauma impacts, serious health conditions, and other barriers caused by abuse that can be lasting and disruptive. Services will also include housing search and placement assistance, case management and other support in collaboration with OC United Way to secure rental housing for prioritized survivors.

Human Options, as the lead agency for the collective domestic violence service organizations is the only vendor that has the technical knowledge and capacity needed to quickly implement this program, which has an aggressive timeline set forth by the funding agency. Human Options is representing three organizations in Orange County that have experience serving this population and the capability to coordinate with other agencies and promote support services that will augment the EHV program.

The costs related to this contract are commensurable with other providers, as the provider is the lead agency representing a collaborative of Victim Service Provider agencies in Orange County that will administer these services. No other vendors were engaged for these services, as no others met this requirement.

If the recommended vendor was not available, the County of Orange would have been challenged to provide specialized supportive services to survivors of domestic violence who are issued an EHV. The EVH program implementation timeline is aggressive and complex and requires immediate augmentation of services to ensure successful implementation for the County of Orange and for the households serviced. Additionally, the County of Orange would be challenged to provide the needed specialized services to survivors of domestic violence experiencing homelessness throughout the Orange County until another provider was designated as the lead agency for Victim Service Providers.


