AGREEMENT 1 **BETWEEN THE** 2 **COUNTY OF ORANGE** 3 AND THE 4 **CITY OF ANAHEIM** 5 6 THIS AGREEMENT is entered into this First day of August 2024, which 7 date is enumerated for purposes of reference only, by and between the COUNTY OF 8 ORANGE a political subdivision of the STATE OF CALIFORNIA, hereinafter referred 9 to as "COUNTY" and CITY OF ANAHEIM, a municipal corporation, hereinafter referred 10 to as "CITY". 11 WITNESSETH: 12 WHEREAS, CITY wishes to contract with COUNTY Sheriff-Coroner 13 Department, hereinafter referred to as "SHERIFF", for Hazardous Devices Squad 14 support during certain events; and 15 WHEREAS, COUNTY is agreeable to the rendering of such services, as 16 authorized in Government Code Sections 51301 and 55632, on the terms and 17 conditions hereinafter set forth: 18 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED AS FOLLOWS: 19 // 20 // 21 22 // 23 // 24 | | | 25 | | | 26 27 28

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A. TERM:

The term of this Agreement shall be for five years, commencing September 1, 2024 and terminating August 31, 2029, unless earlier terminated by either party in the manner set forth herein.

B. OPTIONAL TERMINATION:

COUNTY or CITY may terminate this Agreement, without cause, upon twenty (20) days written notice to the other party.

C. SERVICES BY COUNTY:

CITY occasionally has a need for support from the Sheriff's Hazardous Devices Squad during special events. At the discretion of SHERIFF, COUNTY may provide such support services as requested by CITY. These services will be utilized within the COUNTY OF ORANGE. CITY shall notify COUNTY at least thirty (30) days in advance of the need for these services. Services include Federal Bureau of Investigation certified Bomb Technicians, certified Explosive Detection Canines, and any other Hazardous Devices Squad resources, at the discretion of the Sheriff.

D. PAYMENT:

- Pursuant to Government Code Section 51350, CITY agrees to pay to COUNTY the costs of performing the services mutually agreed upon in this Agreement. The cost of services includes: salaries, wages, benefits, mileage, services, supplies, and divisional, departmental and COUNTY General overhead.
- 2. The rate charged to CITY by COUNTY shall be computed by SHERIFF in accordance with COUNTY Auditor-Controller's law enforcement cost study in effect at the time the services are provided.
- 3. COUNTY shall invoice CITY upon completion of the specific event.

D. PAYMENT: (Continued)

- 4. CITY shall pay COUNTY in accordance with COUNTY Board of Supervisors' approved County Billing Policy, which is attached hereto as Attachment A, and incorporated herein by this reference.
- COUNTY shall charge CITY late payment penalties in accordance with County Billing Policy.

E. ALTERATION OF TERMS:

This Agreement fully expresses all understanding of CITY and COUNTY with respect to the subject matter of this Agreement, and shall constitute the total Agreement between the parties for these purposes. No addition to, or alteration of, the terms of this Agreement shall be valid unless made in writing, formally approved and executed by duly authorized agents of both parties.

F. STATUS OF COUNTY:

COUNTY is, and shall at all times be deemed to be, an independent contractor. Nothing herein contained shall be construed as creating the relationship of employer and employee, or principal and agent, between CITY and COUNTY or any of COUNTY'S agents or employees. COUNTY and its SHERIFF shall retain all authority for rendition of services, standards of performance, control of personnel, and other matters incident to the performance of services by COUNTY pursuant to this Agreement. COUNTY, its agents and employees, shall not be entitled to any rights or privileges of CITY employees and shall not be considered in any manner to be CITY employees.

G. INDEMNIFICATION:

1. COUNTY, its officers, agents and employees shall not be deemed to have assumed any liability for the negligence or any other act or omission of CITY or any of its officers or employees, or for any dangerous or defective condition of any public street or work or property of CITY, or for any illegality or unconstitutionality of CITY'S municipal ordinances. CITY shall indemnify

G. INDEMNIFICATION: (Continued)

and hold COUNTY, its officers, agents, employees, and independent contractors free and harmless from any claim or liability whatsoever, based or asserted upon the condition of any public street or work or property of CITY or upon the illegality or unconstitutionality of any municipal ordinances of CITY that SHERIFF had enforced, or upon any act or omission of CITY, its officers, agents, employees, subcontractors or independent contractors related to this Agreement, for property damage, bodily injury or death or any other element of damage of any kind or nature, and CITY shall defend at its expense, including attorney fees, COUNTY, its officers, agents, employees and independent contractors in any legal action or claim of any kind based upon such condition of public street or work or property, or alleged illegality or unconstitutionality of a municipal ordinance, or alleged acts or omissions.

2. COUNTY shall indemnify and hold CITY, its officers, agents, employees and independent contractors free and harmless from any claim or liability whatsoever, based or asserted upon any act or omission of COUNTY, its officers, agents, employees, subcontractors or independent contractors related to this Agreement, for property damage, bodily injury or death or any other element of damage of any kind or nature, and COUNTY shall defend at its expense, including attorney fees, CITY, its officers, agents, employees and independent contractors in any legal action or claim of any kind based upon such alleged acts or omissions.
