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PLEASE BRIEFLY EXPLAIN WHY YOU WISH TO SERVE ON THIS BOARD, COMMITTEE, OR COMMISSION.

I would respectfully request the opportunity to return for another term on the Commission to End Homelessness in Orange County, and for the chance to work alongside commission members with the Director of Care Coordination to focus on regional policy and implementation strategies, affordable housing development, data and gaps analysis, best practice research, social policy, and systemic change.

I have more than 20 years of experience in housing and homeless services, and bring an indepth understanding of homeless services and housing policy and development, including real estate lending and investment, and asset management of supportive housing. As Chief Executive Officer of American Family Housing, it is my role to drive the organization to fulfill its mission, overseeing all aspects of operations including development, finance, real estate, and program design and management. In my role as a practitioner in the area of affordable housing and homeless services, I am well familiar with the community, interested stakeholders, and what it takes to promote effective responses to homelessness within Orange County. The nonprofit I oversee,

https://www.ocnonprofitcentral.org/organizations/american-family-housing, has developed or at times operated more than three-quarters of the housing units in Orange County that have been funded or are expected to be funded under the statewide Homekey program. These complicated programs involve real estate development, services integration, and collaborative relationships at all levels. Additionally, our team has been an early implementer of new approaches to sustainable services implementation, such as the integration of healthcare into housing.

The Commission offers an opportunity for us to promote greater community understanding of the complex dynamics underlying homelessness. We will need this understanding as we addresses gaps in services and resources in Orange County's System of Care for those experiencing homelessness.
