AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF ORANGE, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING DIRECTOR OF GSA TO GRANT OR OTHERWISE CONVEY BASEMENTS IN REAL PROPERTY, NOT EXCEEDING \$25,000 IN VALUE, TO PUBLIC ENTITIES.

SECTION 1. Article 13 is hereby added to Division 4 of Title 1 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of

- (a) This section is enacted pursuant to Government Code Section 25526.6, and the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes il Director of GSA, or his designee, to grant or otherwise convey easements, not exceeding \$25,000 in value, and to approve and execute the following types of collateral instruments: Easement Deed, Easement Deed and Agreement, Grant of Easemen and Escrew Instructions for Conveyance of Basements, when the following four criteria are met:
  - (1) The value of the easement does not exceed \$25,000 for each extend as determined by GSA/Real Estate.
  - (2) The easement is to be granted or otherwise conveyed to the State, or to any county, city, district, or public
  - (3) The conveyance of the easement is in the public interest and such conveyance will not substantially conflict or
  - (4) The easement documents have been approved by County Counsal and the operating agency/department.
- (b) The Board of Supervisors hereby directs the Director of General Service: Agency to apply the following three-limiting
  - (1) The value of easements granted under this authority to any one entity within one fiscal year shall not exceed
  - (2) The number of easements granted under this authority to any one entity shall not exceed ten per fiscal year, with the exception that easements required by public agencies and utility companies, to provide utility service to County buildings and facilities, shall not be counted toward this limitation of ten per fiscal year.
  - (3) The value of all easements granted under this authority shall be limited to a cumulative value not to exceed
- (c) The Board of Supervisors hereby directs the Director of GSA to submit the annual report to the Board of the easements
- SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force thirty (30) days from and after its passage and, before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after the passage thereof, shall be published once in the Register newspaper published in the County of Orange, State of California, together with the names of the members of the Board of Supervisors voting for or against the same.
