This AMENDMENT No. 1 to Contract 017-23011310 (hereinafter referred to as "Amendment No. 1") is made and entered into as of the date fully executed by and between the County of Orange, a political subdivision of the State of California ("County") and CSG Advisors Incorporated, ("Contractor"), with County and Contractor sometimes individually referred to as "Party" or collectively referred to as "Parties".

**Recitals**

WHEREAS, County and Contractor entered into Contract 017-23011310 for General Public Finance Municipal Advisory Services, effective April 10, 2023, through April 9, 2026, in the Not-to-Exceed Amount of \$200,000 per contract year, ("Contract"); and,

WHEREAS, the Parties now desire to amend the Contract's Termination provision and Renew the Contract, as permitted under Contract 017-23011310, for two (2) years, effective April 10, 2026, through April 9, 2028, with a Not-to-Exceed Amount of \$200,000 per contract year; and,

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties agree as follows:

**AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT ARTICLES**

1. "Termination" of the Contract shall be replaced and amended to include the following:

This Agreement may be terminated or suspended with cause by either Party at any time, provided that the Party initiating termination provides the other Party at least ten (10) days advance written notice of such termination or suspension. In the event of such termination, the County shall only be liable for payment under the payment provisions of this Agreement for satisfactory services rendered or supplies actually furnished prior to the effective date of termination.

2. "Term of Contract" of the Contract shall be amended to include the following:



Contract shall renew for two (2) years, effective April 10, 2026, through April 9, 2028, unless otherwise terminated as provided herein.

3. All other terms and conditions in this Contract shall remain unchanged and with full force and effect.

\* If the contracting party is a corporation, (2) two signatures are required: one (1) signature by the Chairman of the Board, the President or any Vice President; and one (1) signature by the Secretary, any Assistant Secretary, the Chief Financial Officer or any Assistant Treasurer. The signature of one person alone is sufficient to bind a corporation, as long as he or she holds corporate offices in each of the two categories described above. For County purposes, proof of such dual office holding will be satisfied by having the individual sign the instrument twice, each time indicating his or her office that qualifies under the above described provision. In the alternative, a single corporate signature is acceptable when accompanied by a corporate resolution demonstrating the legal authority of the signee to bind the corporation.
