# FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT BETWEEN COUNTY OF ORANGE AND ACCESS CALIFORNIA SERVICES FOR THE PROVISION OF REFUGEE SOCIAL SERVICES

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT, made and entered into upon execution of all necessary signatures, is to that certain AGREEMENT Number WGM0719 between the parties hereto, hereinafter referred to as the "Agreement" and is by and between the COUNTY OF ORANGE, hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY," and Access California Services, a California non-profit corporation, hereinafter referred to as "CONTRACTOR." This Amendment shall be administered by the County of Orange Social Services Agency, hereinafter referred to as "ADMINISTRATOR."

## WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, on October 1, 2020, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR entered into an Agreement for the provision of Refugee Social Services (RSS), for the term of October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2023;

WHEREAS, COUNTY agrees<u>desires</u> to increase funding by an additional \$128,738 for services to clients referred to CONTRACTOR by COUNTY, and amend Subparagraph 20.1 of the Agreement, and amend Subparagraph 11 of Exhibit A of the Agreement;

WHEREAS, COUNTY agrees<u>desires</u> to amend <u>the annual budget and contract maximum</u> <u>obligation in Paragraph 11</u>, Subparagraph 12.1, and Subparagraph 13.1 of Exhibit A of the Agreement;

WHEREAS, CONTRACTOR agrees to continue to provide such services under the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement; and

#### ACCORDINGLY, THE PARTIES AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Subparagraph 20.1 of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

### "20.1 Maximum Contractual Obligation

The maximum obligation of COUNTY under this Agreement shall not exceed the amount of \$1,478,738, or actual allowable costs, whichever is less. The estimated annual amount for each twelve (12) month period is as follows:

20.1.1 \$492,913 for October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2021;

20.1.2 \$535,825 for October 1, 2021 through September 30, 2022; and

20.1.3 \$450,000 for October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2023."

 The annual budget and contract maximum funding obligation of <u>Subp</u>Paragraph 11 of Exhibit A of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

#### "11. <u>BUDGET</u>

The annual budget for services provided pursuant to Exhibit A of this Agreement is set forth as follows:

<sup>(1)</sup> Direct Service Costs are costs that are incurred and specifically allocable to the provision of services identified in this Agreement. Employee Benefits include contributions to 401k or retirement plans; health insurance; dental insurance; life insurance; long term disability insurance; payroll taxes such as FICA, Federal Unemployment Tax, State Unemployment Tax, and Workers' Compensation Tax, based on the currently prevailing rates; and expense for accrued vacation time payout, for a separated employee, limited to the actual vacation time accrued during the fiscal year in which the expense is claimed, minus the actual vacation time used by the employee during said fiscal year. The overall benefit rate shall not exceed the actual salary expense claimed.

<sup>(2)</sup> Indirect Costs are costs that are incurred for an organization's common objectives and that cannot be readily identified with a particular final cost objective."

3. Subparagraph 12.1 of Exhibit A of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

"12.1 <u>CONTRACTOR shall provide the following described staff positions continuously</u> <u>throughout the term of the Agreement:</u>

<sup>(1)</sup> For hourly employees, Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) is defined as the amount of time (stated as a percentage) the position will be providing services under the terms of this Agreement. This percentage is based upon a 40-hour work week. For salaried employees, FTE is defined as the amount of time (stated as a percentage) the position will be paid for under the terms of this Agreement, regardless of the number of hours actually worked.

<sup>(2)</sup> Maximum hourly rate which will be permitted during the term of this Agreement; employees may be paid at less than maximum hourly rate."

- 4. Subparagraph 13.1 of Exhibit A of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:
  - "13.1 Program Director I / II
    - 13.1.1 Duties
      - 13.1.1.1 Oversee all segments of the RSS program.
      - 13.1.1.2 Supervise Program Manager and provide necessary coverage in his/her absence.
        - 13.1.1.2.1 Oversee and assist Program Manager with completion of all required reporting.
      - 13.1.1.3 Attend all County meetings and trainings.
      - 13.1.1.4 Validate monthly and annual statistical data and reports; complete RS-50 monthly and quarterly reports and deliver to ADMINISTRATOR.
      - 13.1.1.5 Ensure RSS program is implemented according to this Agreement.
      - 13.1.1.6 Oversee Quality Control Plan.
      - 13.1.1.7 Complete internal evaluations to constantly enhance program deliverables.
      - 13.1.1.8 Present EPW as required.
      - 13.1.1.9 Report to Executive Director.
      - 13.1.1.10 Collaborate with Executive Director to hire RSS staff.
      - 13.1.1.11 Collaborate with other CBOs to strengthen and expand the RSS program.
    - 13.1.2 Qualifications
      - 13.1.2.1 A minimum of two (2) years of experience in a human services related field. Experience working with the refugee community is preferred.
      - 13.1.2.2 Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university, preferably in a human services field. Two (2) years of course work in an accredited college or university plus two (2) years of

employment experience, preferably in a human services field, may substitute for the bachelor's degree.

- 5. The parties agree that separate copies of this Amendment may be signed by each of the parties, and this Amendment will have the same force and effect as if the original had been signed by all parties.
- 6. All others terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain the same and in full force and in effect.
