

FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
COUNTY OF ORANGE
AND
NEW ALTERNATIVES, INC.
FOR THE PROVISION OF TRANSITIONAL RESIDENTIAL HOME SERVICES
AT TUSTIN FAMILY CAMPUS

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT, made and entered into upon execution of all necessary signatures, is to that certain AGREEMENT Number CJC0620 between the parties hereto, hereinafter referred to as the “Agreement” and is by and between the COUNTY OF ORANGE, hereinafter referred to as “COUNTY,” and NEW ALTERNATIVES, INC., a California non-profit corporation, hereinafter referred to as “CONTRACTOR.” This Amendment shall be administered by the County of Orange Social Services Agency, hereinafter referred to as “ADMINISTRATOR.”

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, on April 28, 2020, the Board approved Agreement CJC0620 for the provision of Transitional Residential Home Services at Tustin Family Campus, for the term of July 1, 2020, through June 30, 2021;

WHEREAS, COUNTY desires to renew the term of the Agreement for an additional twelve (12) months from July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2022;

WHEREAS, COUNTY desires to amend Paragraph 1, Subparagraph 10.4.2.3, Subparagraph 34.3, and Paragraph 38 of the Agreement;

WHEREAS, CONTRACTOR agrees to such amendments and to continue to provide such services under the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement; and

WHEREAS, such services are authorized and provided for pursuant to for pursuant to Health and Safety Code (HSC) Sections 1559.110 to 1559.115, and Welfare and Institutions Code (WIC) Sections 11400(r) and (s), 11403.2, and 16522.1.

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ACCORDINGLY, THE PARTIES AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Paragraph 1 of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

“1. TERM

The term of this Agreement shall commence on July 1, 2020, and terminate on June 30, 2022, unless earlier terminated pursuant to the provisions of Paragraph 40 of this Agreement; provided, however, CONTRACTOR shall be obligated to perform such duties as would normally extend beyond this term, including, but not limited to, obligations with respect to indemnification, audits, reporting, and accounting.

2. Subparagraph 10.4.2.3 of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

3. Subparagraph 34.3 of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

“34.3 CONTRACTOR shall service COUNTY during emergencies and/or declared disaster under the same terms and conditions that apply during non-emergency/disaster conditions. With the exception of overtime hours which require pre-authorization, reimbursement of ordinary expenditures provided during or after an emergency/disaster shall be calculated by the same rates that apply during non-emergency/disaster conditions. Additionally, any costs to continue services to clients during an emergency and/or disaster shall be incurred by the Contractor. These costs may include, but are not limited to: Personal Protective Equipment or other supplies necessary to conduct business during an emergency and/or disaster.”

4. Paragraph 38 of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

“38. CERTIFICATION AND DISCLOSURE REGARDING PAYMENTS TO INFLUENCE CERTAIN FEDERAL TRANSACTIONS

38.1 CONTRACTOR shall be in compliance with Section 319 of Public Law 101-121 pursuant to Section 1352, Title 31, U.S. Code. Under these laws and regulations, it is mutually understood that any contract which utilizes federal monies in excess of \$100,000 must contain and CONTRACTOR must certify compliance utilizing a form provided by ADMINISTRATOR that includes the text below in Subparagraphs 38.1.1 - 38.1.1.4

38.1.1 The undersigned certifies to the best of his or her knowledge and belief that:

38.1.1.1 No federal appropriated funds have been paid or will be paid, by or on behalf of the undersigned, to any person for influencing or attempting to influence an officer or employee of an agency, a Member of Congress, an officer or employee of Congress, or an employee of a Member of Congress in connection with the awarding of any federal contract, the making of any federal grant, the making of any federal loan, the entering into of any cooperative agreement, and the extension, continuation, renewal, amendment, or modification of any federal contract, grant, loan or cooperative agreement.

38.1.1.2 If any funds other than federal appropriated funds have been

paid or will be paid to any person for influencing or attempting to influence an officer or employee of any agency, a Member of Congress, an officer or employee of Congress, or an employee of a Member of Congress in connection with this Agreement, grant, loan, or cooperative agreement, the undersigned shall complete and submit Standard Form-LLL "Disclosure Form to Report Lobbying," in accordance with its instructions.

38.1.1.3 The undersigned shall require that the language of this certification be included in the award documents for all subawards at all tiers (including subcontracts, subgrants, and contracts under grants loans and cooperative agreements) and that subrecipients shall certify and disclose accordingly.

38.1.1.4 This certification is a material representation of fact upon which reliance was placed when this transaction was made or entered into. Submission of this certification is a prerequisite for making or entering into this transaction imposed by Section 1352, Title 31 U.S. Code. Any person who fails to file the required certification shall be subject to a civil penalty of not less than \$10,000 and not more than \$100,000 for each such failure."

5. The parties agree that separate copies of this Amendment may be signed by each of the parties, and this Amendment will have the same force and effect as if the original had been signed by all parties.
6. All other terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain the same and in full force and in effect.

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WHEREFORE, the parties hereto have executed this First Amendment to Agreement dated July 1, 2020 in the County of Orange, California.
