**AMENDMENT NO. 2
FOR
MAINTENANCE REPAIR OF WATER CHILLERS**

This AMENDMENT is made and entered into as of the date fully executed by and between the County of Orange, a political subdivision of the State of California ("County") and ACCO Engineered Systems, Inc., with a place of business at 888 East Walnut Street, Pasadena CA 91101 ("Contractor"), with County and Contractor sometimes individually referred to as "Party" or collectively referred to as "Parties".

RECITALS

WHEREAS, County and Contractor entered into Contract MA-080-17011044 for Maintenance Repair of Water Chillers, effective March 28, 2017, through March 27, 2022, in the Total Aggregate Contract Amount of \$5,000,000, ("Contract"); and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Amendment 1, the Parties amended the contract to delete Article 12, Conflict of Interest and Article 44, Change of Ownership, and add Article 60, Change of Ownership/Name, Litigation Status, Conflicts with County Interests in their place; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Amendment 1, the Parties amended Article 24 to reflect changes to the Contract's Notice information; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Amendment 1, the Parties amended Attachment C of the Contract to revise the list of equipment to be serviced; and,

WHEREAS, the Parties now desire to amend Contract's Notice Information; and,

WHEREAS, the Parties now desire to amend Attachment B, Section II.B., Miscellaneous Item Discount Structure of the Contract; and,

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties agree as follows:

AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT ARTICLES

2. Attachment B, Section II.B. shall be amended in its entirety as follows:

Miscellaneous Item Discount Structure: Miscellaneous Items may be purchased against the Contract. Miscellaneous Item purchases shall not exceed \$5,000 per invoice, including tax, unless the following process is followed.

Miscellaneous Items ranging between \$5,000 and \$25,000, including tax, must be pre-approved by the County Project Manager or Designee prior to processing. The County will obtain price quotes from Contractor for all

Miscellaneous Items purchased between \$5,000 and \$25,000.

The Contractor shall provide original cost receipts of all items cost of \$100 or more.

3. All other terms and conditions contained in the Contract shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

* If the contracting party is a corporation, (2) two signatures are required: one (1) signature by the Chairman of the Board, the President or any Vice President; and one (1) signature by the Secretary, any Assistant Secretary, the Chief Financial Officer or any Assistant Treasurer.
