HIV Housing Services

This Amendment ("Amendment No. 89") to Contract No. MA-042-18010374 for HIV Housing Services is made and entered into on January 15May 25, 2021,— ("Effective Date") between AIDS Services Foundation Orange County dba Radiant Health Centers ("Contractor"), with a place of business at 17982 Sky Park Circle, Suite J, Irvine, CA 92614, and the County of Orange, a political subdivision of the State of California ("County"), through its Health Care Agency, with a place of business at 405 W. 5th St., Ste. Street, Suite 600, Santa Ana, CA 92701. Contractor and County may sometimes be referred to individually as "Party" or collectively as "Parties".

RECITALS

WHEREAS, on May 23, 2017, the Parties executed Contract No. MA-042-18010374 for HIV Housing Services, effective July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2020, in an amount not to exceed \$1,462,290, renewable for two additional one-year Periods ("Contract"); and

-WHEREAS, on April 5, 2018, the Parties agreed to decrease the Period One Maximum Obligation by \$25,497, for a modified revised total contract amount not to exceed \$1,436,793; and

-WHEREAS, on August 8, 2018, the Parties executed Amendment No. 1 to amend the Contract, effective July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2020, contractor name due to a fictitious name change and to amend Exhibit A., to exercise the cost contingency to increase to the Period Two Maximum Obligation by \$48,743, for a modified revised total contract amount not to exceed \$1,485,536, and to amend Exhibit A of the Contract to reflect this increase; and

WHEREAS, on June 2, 2020, the Parties executed Amendment No. 2 to increase the Period Three Maximum Obligation by \$276,000, for a modified revised total contract amount not to exceed \$1,761,536, and to amend Exhibit A of the Contract to reflect this increase; and

WHEREAS, on July 1, 2020, the Parties executed Amendment No. 3 to renew the contractContract for a period of one year, effective July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021, in an amount not to exceed \$554,985 for thisthe renewal period, for a newrevised total contract amount not to exceed \$2,316,521, and renewable for one additional one-year period; and to amend Standard language paragraphs and, Exhibit A of the Contract; and

WHEREAS, on August 24, 2020, the Parties executed Amendment No. 4 to increase the Period Four Maximum Obligation by \$126,372, for a modified revised total contract amount not to exceed \$2,442,893, and to amend Exhibit A of the Contract to the reflect thethis increase; and

WHEREAS, on September 1, 2020, the Parties executed Amendment No. 5 to increase the Period Four Maximum Obligation by an additional \$500,000 in CARES Act funds, for a modified revised total contract amount not to exceed \$2,942,893, to include add Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) required contract provisions, and to amend Exhibit A of the Contract to reflect this increase; and,

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WHEREAS, on October 14, 2020, the Parties executed Amendment No. 6 to increase the Period Four Maximum Obligation by an additional \$65,000 in Ryan White Part A funds for Short-Term Supportive Housing Services, for a modified revised total contract amount not to exceed \$3,007,893; and to amend Exhibit A of the Contract to reflect this increase; and

WHEREAS, on December 31, 2020, the Parties executed Amendment No. 7 to increase the Period Four Maximum Obligation by an additional \$996,000 in Infectious Disease Infrastructure State funds for EFA-Payments and for Short-Term Supportive Housing Services, for a modified revised total contract amount not to exceed \$4,003,893; and to amend Exhibit A of the Contract to reflect this increase; and

WHEREAS, on January 15, 2021, the Parties now desire to enter into thisexecuted Amendment No. 8 to decrease the Period Four Maximum Obligation by \$830,000 in Infectious Disease Infrastructure State funds for EFA-Payments and for Short-Term Supportive Housing Services, and to increase the Period Four Maximum Obligation by \$103,000 in HOPWA COVID 19 funds by \$103,000 for EFA-Payments, for a modified revised total contract amount not to exceed \$3,276,893; and, to amend Exhibit A of the Contract to reflect this increase; and

WHEREAS, on April 13, 2021, the Board of Supervisors retroactively approved Amendments No. 4, No. 6, No. 7, and No. 8; and

WHEREAS, the Parties now desire to enter into this Amendment No. 9 to increase the Period Four Maximum Obligation by \$58,333 in Epidemiology and Laboratory Capacity for Prevention and Control of Emerging Infectious Diseases Enhancing Detection Expansion (ELC Expansion) funds and to amend Exhibit A of the Contract to reflect this increase; and

NOW THEREFORE, Contractor and County, in consideration of the above recitals, and in consideration of the mutual covenants, benefits and promises contained herein, agree to amend the Contract as follows:

- 1) The Period Four Maximum Obligation is decreased by \$727,00058,333 from \$2,2421,515,357 to \$1,515,357573,690, for a new revised total contract amount not to exceed \$3,276,893, on the amended terms and conditions 335,226.
- 2) Page 4, Referenced Contract Provisions, lines 8 through 12 of the Contract isare deleted in itstheir entirety and replaced with the following:

B. Any increases or decreases to the budget must be approved, in advance and in writing, by ADMINISTRATOR. Administrative Costs shall not exceed ten percent (10%) of total costs.

C. BUDGET/STAFFING MODIFICATIONS - CONTRACTOR shall make written application to ADMINISTRATOR, in advance, to shift funds between budgeted line items for the purpose of meeting specific program needs, or for providing continuity of care to its members, by utilizing a Budget/Staffing Modification Request form provided by ADMINISTRATOR. CONTRACTOR shall submit a properly completed Budget/Staffing Modification Request to ADMINISTRATOR for consideration, in advance, which shall include a justification narrative specifying the purpose of the request, the amount of said funds to be shifted, and the sustaining

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impact of the shift as may be applicable to the current contract Period and/or future contract Periods. CONTRACTOR shall obtain written approval of any Budget/Staffing Modification Request(s) from ADMINISTRATOR prior to implementation by CONTRACTOR. Failure of CONTRACTOR to obtain written approval from ADMINISTRATOR for any proposed Budget/Staffing Modification Request(s) may result in disallowance of those costs.

- D. CONTRACTOR shall submit a budget revision request to ADMINISTRATOR to request budget changes hereafter. The budget revision request shall be on a form approved or provided by ADMINISTRATOR.
