The results of this study have been presented to the Commission and the Commission will be working on utilizing the information and findings to develop additional recommendations to the Board on homelessness prevention efforts.

F5 and R2 referring to an entity that no longer exists. The Commission to End Homelessness, now renamed the Commission to Address Homelessness by the OC -BOS In 2018. It's is the Office of Care Coordination who sets the agenda for that Commission.
