RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF
ORANGE COUNTY, CALIFORNIA

October 8, 1985

On motion of Supervisor Wieder, duly seconded and carried, the following Resolution was adopted:

BE IT RESOLVED that this Board hereby orders the following:

1. Increase the existing 40 mph speed limit on Esplanade between Seventeenth and Fairhaven to 45 mph.
2. Increase the existing 40 mph speed limit on Fairhaven between Hewes and Yorba to 45 mph.
3. Increase the existing 35 mph speed limit on Foothill between Newport and Arroyo to 40 mph.
4. Retain the existing 35 mph speed limit on Hewes between Seventeenth and Fairhaven.
5. Retain the existing 45 mph speed limit on Irvine between Red Hill and Browning.
6. Increase the existing 40 mph speed limit on Newport Avenue between Wass and Crawford Canyon to 45 mph. Review the curve south of Crawford Canyon for speed advisory signing.
7. Retain the existing 45 mph speed limit on Newport Boulevard between Crawford Canyon and Orange City Limits. Review the curved portions between Rockhurst and Crawford Canyon for speed advisory signing and lane transition striping.

- 1 8. Retain the existing 40 mph speed limits on Prospect
2 (north) between Seventeenth and Fairhaven.
- 3 9. Defer action to modify speed zoning for Prospect
4 Avenue (south). Request staff to contact City of
5 Tustin for concurrence on raising the present limit
6 to 45 mph in both jurisdictions. In the absence
7 of proper posting, do not allow radar speed en-
8 forcement.
- 9 10. Increase the existing 35 mph speed limit on Red Hill
10 to 45 mph between Irvine and La Colina and 40 mph
11 between La Colina and Southeast Skyline. Establish
12 a 40 mph speed limit between Southeast Skyline and
13 La Loma. Add edgeline striping to those areas which
14 do not have curb and gutter improvements.
- 15 11. Increase the existing 35 mph speed limit on Santa
16 Clara between Prospect and Yorba to 40 mph.
- 17 12. Retain the existing 45 mph speed limit on Seventeenth
18 between Prospect and Newport.
- 19 13. Establish a 40 mph speed limit between Darlene and
20 Hunting Horn, and a 30 mph speed limit on Skyline be-
21 tween Hunting Horn and Cowan Heights. Review the
22 curved portion of Skyline south of La Vereda for
23 additional curve delineation by signing and pavement
24 markings.


