

Sole Source/ Proprietary Request Form

COUNTY POLICY ON SOLE SOURCE CONTRACTS:

It is the policy of the County of Orange to solicit competitive bids and proposals for its procurement requirements. Sole source procurement shall not be used unless there is clear and convincing evidence that only one source exists to fulfill the County's requirements. All sole source purchases requiring Board of Supervisors approval shall be justified as meeting the sole source standard in the Agenda Staff Report. The Agenda Staff Report shall clearly state that it is a sole source procurement. The Sole Source Justification, as described below, shall be attached within the Agenda Staff Report (CPM, Section 4.4)

SECTION I – INSTRUCTION FOR COMPLETING THIS FORM:

- 1. Formal justification is required for sole source procurements when competitive bid guidelines require pricing from competing firms.
- 2. A written justification will be prepared by the department and approved by the department head or designee.
- 3. Prior to execution of a contract, the County Purchasing Agent or designee shall approve ALL sole source requests for commodities that exceed \$250,000 and services exceeding \$50,000 or a two (2) year consecutive term, regardless of the contract amount.
- 4. If vendor is a retired, former Orange County employee, CEO Budget shall approve the sole source request, regardless of the sole source amount.
- 5. Board approval is required for all sole source contracts for commodities that exceed \$250,000 and services exceeding \$50,000 or a two (2) year consecutive term, regardless of the contract amount.
- 6. The Deputy Purchasing Agent (DPA) shall retain a copy of the justification as part of the contract file.
- 7. Valid sole source request contain strong technological and/or programmatic justifications.
- 8. Sole source procurements may be approved based upon emergency situations in which there is not adequate time for competitive bidding.
- 9. Sole source requests for Human Service contracts will be guided by the regulations of the funding source.
- 10. Each question in Section III of this form must be answered in detail and signed by the department head with concurrence of the Deputy Purchasing Agent.

 Software maintenance and support for EnvisionConnect, EnvisionConnect Portal and Press Agent systems for Health Care Ageny/Environmental Health (HCA/EH). The current division-wide electronic data system is a proprietary software system owned and licensed exclusively through Decade Software Company, LLC. This software allows HCA/EH staff members to store and manage all of Environmental Health data in the areas of inspections, violations, permits, invoices, and timekeeping. The system supports wireless, portable field computing for inspections, allows inspection data to be posted on the website, and provides for automated reporting to the State. The system also supports the integration of the EnvisionConnect database, Envision Connect Portal and the Press Agency system used for providing online inspection results. Please see attached Scope of Work for detail information.
- 3. Please state why the recommended vendor is the only one capable of providing the required supplies and/or commodities.  - EnvisionConnect is a proprietary software data management system currently in use at HCA/EH. There is currently only one known web-based system, EnvisionConnect Portal, that can fully integrate with EnvisionConnect and is provided by Decade Software Company LLC through their subcontractor, E-Compliance. HCA/EH has worked with Decade Software Company LLC and their subcontractor since 2008 to develop a customized Portal that will meet the legislative electronic reporting requirement found in Health and Safety Code Section 25404(e). This mandated internet based portal links our system to fire department agencies, cities and businesses, providing a mechanism to exchange vital information related to hazardous materials. The Portal has also been customized to enhance client/public usage through the development of a system to allow fee payments to be made online by businesses. Other enhancements that have been made over the years include the Certified Unified Program Agency consolidated billing component that was custom built into the extensive accounting module within the system, and the popular enhancement for HCA/EH's public notification module, which allows the public to view restaurant inspection information online, without having to make a public records request. Decade Software Company, LLC has developed a particular expertise through demonstrated past performance, which has been investigated and determined to be satisfactory regarding their support and maintenance of Environmental Health's database system, and HCA/EH would be adversely affected operationally and monetarily by bringing in another vendor who would be required to meet Decade's level of expertise, existing knowledge and involvement in specific database projects. contracted pertaining to the upgrade, installation, customization, maintenance, and support can only be obtained through Decade Software Company, LLC.

EnvisionConnect is only available with Decade Software Company LLC. The EnvisionConnect Portal is available through E-Compliance. E-Compliance has an agreement with Decade Software Company LLC to provide integration with EnvisionConnect. Any other third party access to EnvisionConnect Software is prohibited by Decade Software Company, LLC.

5. How does recommended vendor's prices or fees compare to the general market? Attach quotes for comparable services or supplies, if available. Attach additional sheet if necessary.

There are no other vendors who can provide the integration between Decade's proprietary EnvisionConnect, EnvisionConnect Portal, and Press Agency systems that the HCA/EH needs for daily regulatory operations. A solicitation process would be needed to determine the cost of implementing an entirely new customized system that would be able to accomplish everything that is provided by Decade. Los Angeles County Environmental Health has recently gone through the solicitation process and indicated that one-time implementation costs for comparable systems was \$1.6 million dollars. Since Decade and County staff have already customized the EnvisionConnect product to meet the specific needs of HCA/EH, there would be no initial implementation costs associated with this new Decade contract. Los Angeles County Environmental Health has signed a contract with Decade Software Company LLC for the development of their new database system.

6. If recommended vendor could not provide the product or service, how would the County accomplish this particular task? Attach additional sheet if necessary.

Currently HCA/EH utilizes EnvisionConnect for issuing regulatory inspections, tracking of daily program activities, generating regulated business invoices, receiving online business forms, and managing of regulatory program information used for developing workloads and fees. If the recommended vendor could not provide the service or product, these critical services will be interrupted and HCA/EH will be forced to return to a paper system which will negatively impact program operations, certification, services and revenues. In the long-run, if this vendor is not allowed to provide this service, HCA/EH would need to transition to an alternative system, which would result in substantial costs. The cost of transitioning to a new system would include one-time costs for setting up a new system and transferring existing information; IT staff resources for up to 6 months for the development of a detailed scope of work and transition plan; program staff time to work on mapping of existing data, tracking issues, testing and training; and the conversion process would have to include concurrent payments toward the two systems to continue with HCA/EH operations while the new system is under development.
