

**AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO
AGREEMENT FOR ARCHITECT-ENGINEER SERVICES FOR
PROGRAM MANAGEMENT SERVICES
PROJECT NO. P101**

This Amendment No.1 ("Amendment") is made and entered into this _____ day of _____, 2019, by and between the County of Orange, a political subdivision of the State of California ("County"), through its department John Wayne Airport ("JWA"), and Jeff Oviedo and Associates ("Program Manager").

WHEREAS, on June 28, 2016, the County and Program Manager entered into an Architect-Engineer Agreement for the John Wayne Airport Program Management Services in the not-to-exceed amount of \$2,467,120 (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the continuance of Program Management services is needed to provide effective, efficient, and seamless support of JWA's Capital Improvements Program and other airport projects; and

WHEREAS, Program Manager wishes to continue to provide Program Management Services under the terms of the Agreement as amended below.

NOW THEREFORE, the County and Program Manager agree as follows:

- I. The term of the Agreement shall be extended for two additional years, from July 1, 2019, to June 30, 2021, and the not-to-exceed amount shall be increased by \$3,979,744 to a total amended not-to-exceed amount of \$6,446,864.
- II. Program Manager's hourly rates shall be amended to the rates shown on Appendix 1.
- III. All costs associated with JWA badging and SIDA requirements, training, and processing, including associated travel time, shall be the responsibility of the Program Manager and shall not be a reimbursable expense.
- IV. Except as specifically amended herein, all terms and conditions of the Amendment shall remain unchanged, in full force and effect.
- V. The foregoing is in accordance with the Agreement and subject to the following:
 1. The aforementioned change and work affected thereby, is subject to all Agreement stipulations and covenants; and
 2. All claims against the County which are incidental to or as a consequence of the aforementioned changes are fully satisfied and the Program Manager hereby releases the County from all said claims.

Contract hourly rates represent the maximum amounts for each classification, and assume that the individual receiving said maximum hourly rate is the most qualified individual for the given classification based on JWA's business needs. Each individual proposed for a given classification will be evaluated by JWA for their expertise, experience, and qualifications, including years, depth, and breadth of experience and qualifications, and their hourly rate will be determined and agreed upon prior to their placement in a given assignment based on the factors above, up to the not-to-exceed hourly rate listed.
