CONTRACT MA-080-17011475 For Scanning, Indexing, Redaction and Imaging Services

THIS Contract, MA-080-17011475, to provide Scanning, Indexing, Redaction and Imaging Services, hereinafter referred to as ("Contract") is made and entered into as of the date fully executed by and between the County of Orange, a political subdivision of the State of California, hereinafter referred to as ("County") and DocuLynx, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as "Contractor"), with a place of business at 6916 N 97th Circle, Omaha NE 68122-3037 (hereinafter referred to as "Contractor"), with County and Contractor sometimes individually referred to as ("Party"), or collectively referred to as ("Parties").

RECITALS

WHEREAS, County desires to enter into a Contract for a Scanning, Indexing, Redaction and Imaging Services; and,

WHEREAS, the County of Orange, County Executive Office has issued Regional Cooperative Agreement RCA-017-17010006 (hereinafter referred to as "RCA"), now in effect; and,

WHEREAS, Contractor has represented that it is qualified to provide the requested scope of products and services to the County; and,

WHEREAS, Contractor agrees to provide a Scanning, Indexing, Redaction and Imaging Services to the County in accordance with the terms, conditions, and pricing of the Master Contract, incorporated herein by this reference; and,

WHEREAS, County agrees to pay Contractor the fees as further set forth in the Master NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties mutually agree as follows:

ARTICLES

- 1. **Scope of Services:** This Contract specifies the contractual terms and conditions by which the Contractor will provide Scanning, Indexing, Redaction and Imaging Services in accordance with RCA Contract RCA-017-17010006 under a usage Contract.
- 2. Term: Contract shall be effective upon approval by the Orange County Board of Supervisors or on May 7, 2017 upon the execution of all necessary signatures, whichever occurs later and shall continue for one year from the effective date unless otherwise terminated as provided herein. This Contract may be extended or renewed in accordance with the RCA. County is not obligated to give a reason or notice if it elects not to renew. Renewal amendments may require County Board of Supervisors approval

Amendment #1 (Extend Services)

Contract shall be extended effective May 7, 2018 through June 30, 2018.

Amendment #2 (Contract Renewal)

Contract shall be effective upon approval by the Orange County Board of Supervisors or upon execution of all necessary signatures, whichever occurs later, and shall continue for one year from the effective date unless otherwise terminated as provided herein. This Contract may be extended or renewed in accordance with the RCA. County is not obligated to give a reason or notice if it elects not to renew. Renewal amendments may require County Board of Supervisors approval.

- 3. **Compensation:** Contractor agrees to provide Scanning, Indexing, Redaction and Imaging Services as set forth in Attachment A at the fixed rates specified in the RCA.
- 4. Aggregate Contract: This is an aggregate Contract between three Contractors with a Total Aggregate Contract to be split by the three Contractors that shall not exceed \$200,000.\$300,000.
- 5. Notices: Any and all notices, requests demands and other communications contemplated, called for, permitted, or required to be given hereunder shall be in writing, except through the course of the Parties' Project Managers' routine exchange of information and cooperation during the terms of the work and services. Any written communications shall be deemed to have been duly given upon actual in-person delivery, if delivery is by direct hand, or upon delivery on the actual day of receipt or no greater than four calendar days after being mailed by US certified or registered mail, return receipt requested, postage prepaid, whichever occurs first. The date of mailing shall count as the first day. All communications shall be addressed to the appropriate Party at the address stated herein or such other address as the Parties hereto may designate by written notice from time to time in the manner aforesaid.
