**AMENDMENT #1

This AMENDMENT is made and entered into as of the date fully executed by and between the County of Orange, a political subdivision of the State of California, (hereinafter referred to as “County”) and Environmental Logistics, Inc., with a place of business at 140 W. Monte Avenue, Bloomington, CA 92316, (hereinafter referred to as “Contractor”), with County and Contractor sometimes individually referred to as (“Party”) or collectively referred to as (“Parties”).

**RECITALS**

WHEREAS, County and Contractor entered into Contract MA-080-17011161, for On-Call Environmental Clean-Up Services, effective March 27, 2017 through March 26, 2020, in the aggregate amount not to exceed \$1,500,000 (hereinafter referred to as “Contract”); and,

WHEREAS, both Parties now desire to add additional language to Attachment B of the Contract; and,

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties agree as follows:

**ARTICLES**

2. Attachment B, Section II.G shall be amended to read as follows:

**G. Additional Services & Work:** Any disposal, additional labor, tools, equipment or other emergency cleanup charges, etc. not listed above must be approved by the County Project Manager in accordance with Attachment A, “Scope of Work”. Disposal and other charges not already listed in this Fee Schedule may be billed at cost plus any surcharge not to exceed 15%.

3. All other terms and conditions contained in this Contract shall remain unchanged and with full force and effect.

\* If the contracting party is a corporation, (2) two signatures are required: one (1) signature by the Chairman of the Board, the President or any Vice President; and one (1) signature by the Secretary, any Assistant Secretary, the Chief Financial Officer or any Assistant Treasurer. The signature of one person alone is sufficient to bind a corporation, as long as he or she holds corporate offices in each of the two categories described above. For County purposes, proof of such dual office holding will be satisfied by having the individual sign the instrument twice, each time indicating his or her office that qualifies under the above described provision. In the alternative, a single corporate signature is acceptable when accompanied by a corporate resolution demonstrating the legal authority of the signator to bind the corporation.
