The services described in this contract are existing services entered under Resolution of the Board of Supervisors of Orange County, California Authorizing Emergency Contracting Authority dated April 21, 2020. The Board Resolution, Pursuant to Government Code Section 25502.7, allowed the Board of Supervisors to direct the County Procurement Officer (CPO), or designee, to engage independent contractors to perform services related to the COVID-19 Emergency for the County or County officers, with or without the furnishing of material, to the extent that the CPO determined that an immediate, emergency need exists due to imminent threat to life, health, property, or essential public service for a services contract due to the COVID-19 Emergency, no further sole source justification was required for a contract or amendment to be entered into.

The County is the payer of last resort for the COVID-19 Vaccination Services listed on the Master Agreement. Participating providers will be required to bill insurances prior to invoicing the County.

There are 10 providers that have expressed interest in participating in this open opportunity. Provider interest will continue to be accepted and ongoing until the County's needs are met and/or funds are exhausted.

HCA requests that your Honorable Board approve the Master Agreement with various providers for provision of COVID-19 Mobile Vaccination Services and the delegation of authority to execute individual contracts under the Master Agreement, as referenced in the Recommended Actions.
