SUBCONTRACTORS

This contract, due to the nature of the services, could require the addition of subcontractors. In order to add subcontractors to the contract, the contractor must seek express consent from SSA. Should the addition of a subcontractor impact the scope of work and/or contract amount, SSA will bring the item back to the Board of Supervisors for approval. In the past, subcontractors have not been used for this contract.

CONTRACT OPERATING EXPENSES

The maximum obligation of COUNTY under this Agreement shall not exceed the amount of \$750,000, or actual allowable costs, whichever is less. The annual amount for each twelve (12) month period is as follows:

- \$250,000 for July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2022;
- \$250,000 for July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2022; and
- \$250,000 for July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2022.
