On August 23, 2019, the Orange County Sheriff's Department (County) submitted a Debris Management Plan (Plan) for participation in the Public Assistance (PA) Alternative Procedures Pilot Program for Debris Removal conducted by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). The California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES) has reviewed this plan and is returning it.

The FEMA Alternative Procedures Pilot Program is currently suspended and not taking submissions. However, Cal OES has determined that the Plan contains all the basic planning elements as noted in the FEMA Public Assistance Program and Policy Guide Debris Management Plan Checklist to be considered comprehensive and appropriate for promulgation by Orange County.
