### **RECOMMENDED ACTION(S):**

Authorize the County Procurement Officer or authorized Deputy to execute Amendment Number One to the NTT America, Inc. contract for Cisco SMARTnet Maintenance Bundles, for the term of June 29, 2021, through June 28, 2022 in an amount not to exceed for a total contract amount of \$706,117, renewable for one additional one-year term.

#### **SUMMARY:**

Approval of Amendment Number One to the contract with NTT America, Inc. will allow the Sheriff-Coroner Department to continue contracting for Cisco SMARTnet maintenance to ensure the operation of critical systems.

### BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Sheriff-Coroner Department (Sheriff) requires a contract for SMARTnet direct 24 hour technical support coverage and maintenance on all Cisco Systems, Inc. computer equipment in the Sheriff's network. This maintenance is critical because the computer equipment must have continuous maintenance coverage with no lapse in service; otherwise the warranty will be voided. It is imperative that the warranty be in effect in case of equipment failure because the replacement cost of this equipment is substantial. The critical systems that must be maintained are Sheriff's network infrastructure, computer peripheral devices and the Sheriff's intranet. NTT America, Inc. (NTT) is authorized and certified by Cisco Systems, Inc.

On June 26, 2018 the Board of Supervisors (Board) approved the contract with Dimension Data North America Inc. (Dimension) for a contract amount of \$1,525,596, for the term of July 1, 2018, through June 30, 2021. Additionally, on July 1, 2019, Sheriff was notified by Dimension that it had changed its name to NTT. This vendor has been performing satisfactorily. Contractor performance has been confirmed as at least satisfactory. Sheriff has verified that there are no concerns that must be addressed with respect to contractor's ownership/name, litigation status or conflicts with County interests.

NTT is authorized and certified by Cisco Systems, Inc. Sheriff requests Board approval of Amendment Number One to the NTT America, Inc. contract for the term of June 29, 2021, through June 28, 2022 in the amount not to exceed \$706,117 renewable for one additional one-year term. This contract is submitted for Board approval less than 30 days prior to the start of the contract as the negotiation process concluded in late May 2021, which did not allow enough time to file for previous Board meetings. This contract does not include subcontractors or pass through to other providers. See Attachment C for the Contract Summary Form.

The contract falls outside the non-standard insurance provision of the County of Orange. This non-standard insurance provision was not waived by the County Executive Office Risk Management. Sheriff has determined that the services needed and provided by NTT America, Inc. are imperative and outweigh the exceptions the vendor has taken.

#### FINANCIAL IMPACT:

Appropriations for this contract are included in the Sheriff-Coroner's FY 2021-22 Budget for Budget Control 060, and will be included in the budgeting process for future years. This contract contains language allowing the Sheriff-Coroner Department to terminate the contract or reduce the level of services without penalty with cause or without cause in the event that funding is reduced and/or not available to continue funding the contract.
