SUBCONTRACTORS

This contract does not currently include subcontractors or pass through to other providers.

CONTRACT OPERATING EXPENSES

The maximum obligation of COUNTY under this Agreement shall not exceed the amount of \$402,480, or actual allowable costs, whichever is less. The annual amount for each twelve (12) month period is as follows: \$201,240 for July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020; and \$201,240 for July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021. The compensation structure is as follows:

- 1) The rate of one hundred twenty-nine dollars (\$129) per hour will be paid for services provided in accordance with Paragraph 3 of Exhibit A to this Agreement, not to exceed the maximum obligation specified in Subparagraph 20.1 of this Agreement.
- 2) If services occur during an on-call period referenced in Subparagraph 3.2.4, CONTRACTOR will be paid the rate of one hundred twenty-nine dollars (\$129) per hour for each hour in which services are rendered. When services are provided during an on-call period, only the hours during which services are rendered are eligible for compensation. Services lasting less than one (1) hour shall be prorated in thirty (30) minute increments.
- 3) When no service is provided during an on-call period requested by ADMINISTRATOR, CONTRACTOR shall be compensated at a rate of \$32.25 per hour for each hour of on-call service. Please include information regarding contract expenses in this section.
