Project Title: Santa Ana Avenue and University Drive Drainage and Pavement Improvements

Project Location(s): Unincorporated Orange County at the intersection of University Drive and Santa Ana Avenue near the City of Costa Mesa, CA

Project Description: The project includes the design of a pocket park, a storm drain catch basin relocation, and street rehabilitation along University Drive from Willo Lane to Santa Ana Avenue. Project construction is anticipated to take 6 months. The project involves removal and replacement of asphalt concrete curb with concrete curb and gutter, removal of asphalt concrete sidewalk and replacement with concrete sidewalk, removal and replacement of existing concrete curb and gutter where required, construction of ADA compliant curb ramps, reconstruction of driveway approaches and driveways, updating existing signage for traffic and storm drain inlet modifications. A stormwater biorentention basin would be included on the vacant County owned parcel (approximately 5,180 square feet) on the corner of Santa Ana Avenue and University Drive. In addition, the vacant County owned parcel would be landscaped and include tot lot accessory structures.
