



**Amendment Number Two
To Contract Number MA-299-15010501
For Hydroseeding Services**

This Amendment Number Two (“**Amendment**”) to Contract Number MA-299-15010501 for Hydroseeding Services (“**Contract**”) is made and entered into as of the date fully executed by and between the County of Orange, a political subdivision of the State of California, through its OC Waste & Recycling Department (“**County**”), and Ron Dietz, Inc. dba Dietz Hydroseeding Company, with a place of business at 15745 Kadota Street, Sylmar, CA 91342 (“**Contractor**”). County and Contractor are sometimes referred to collectively as “**Parties**.”

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into Contract Number MA-299-15010501 for Hydroseeding Services for a three-year period, effective November 23, 2014 through November 22, 2017, in an amount not to exceed \$940,000; and

WHEREAS, the Parties executed Amendment Number One, replacing Article Y, Waiver of Jury Trial, with “Intentionally left blank,” and renewing the Contract for one year, effective November 23, 2017 through November 22, 2018, in an amount not to exceed \$350,000; and

WHEREAS, County now desires to renew the Contract for one year, effective November 23, 2018 through November 22, 2019, in an amount not to exceed \$350,000;



NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual obligation set forth herein, both County and Contractor agree as follows:

1. Contract Number MA-299-15010501 shall be renewed for one year, effective November 23, 2018 through November 22, 2019, in an amount not to exceed \$350,000, unless otherwise terminated by the County.
2. All other terms and conditions of the Contract, except as amended herein, shall remain unchanged, in full force and effect.


* If the contracting party is a corporation, two (2) signatures are required: one (1) signature by the Chairman of the Board, the President or any Vice President; and one (1) signature by the Secretary, any Assistant Secretary, the Chief Financial Officer or any Assistant Treasurer. The signature of one person alone is sufficient to bind a corporation, as long as he or she holds corporate offices in each of the two categories described above. For County purposes, proof of such dual office holding will be satisfied by having the individual sign the instrument twice, each time indicating his or her office that qualifies under the above described provision. In the alternative, a single corporate signature is acceptable when accompanied by a corporate resolution demonstrating the legal authority of the signee to bind the corporation.
