AMENDMENT No. 1 FOR WATER QUALITY ANALYTICAL SERVICES

This AMENDMENT is made and entered into as of the date fully executed by and between the County of Orange, a political subdivision of the State of California (hereinafter referred to as "County") and Weck Analytical Environmental Services, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as "Contractor"), with County and Contractor sometimes individually referred to as "Party" or collectively referred to as "Parties."

RECITALS

WHEREAS, County and Contractor entered into Contract MA-080-17010712 for Water Quality Analytical Services, effective December 20, 2016 through December 19, 2019, in the Total Aggregate Contract Amount of \$3,210,000.00 (hereinafter referred to as "Contract"); and,

WHEREAS, the Parties now desire to renew the Contract for one (1) year, effective December 20, 2019 through December 19, 2020, with a new Total Aggregate Contract Amount not to exceed \$1,070,000.00; and,

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties agree as follows:

ARTICLES

- 1. Article 2 of the Contract shall be amended to read in its entirety as follows:
 - 2. Term: Contract shall be effective December 20, 2019, and shall continue for one (1) year from that date, unless otherwise terminated as provided herein.
- 2. Article 3 of the Contract shall be amended to read in its entirety as follows:
 - **3. Aggregate Contract:** This is an aggregate Contract between four Contractors with a Total Aggregate Contract Amount not to exceed \$1,070,000.00.
- 3. All other terms and conditions in this Contract shall remain unchanged and with full force and effect.
