Project Title: Santiago Canyon Road Safety Improvements Project

Project Location(s): Santiago Canyon Road, Orange County, CA

Project Description: The County of Orange is proposing to provide 11.7 miles of safety improvements on Santiago Canyon Road, between Live Oak Canyon Road and State Route 241. The proposed project will enhance safety along Santiago Canyon Road and includes the following improvements: increasing pavement friction by the use of a High Friction Surface Treatment, installation of traffic control devices, and restriping the existing bicycle lane to include a buffer. Shoulder grading, tree trimming and vegetation removal may be required along the roadway edge. Excavation of up to five feet in depth will be required for the replacement of guardrail posts. Other appurtenant measures will be included, as needed.
