

**AMENDMENT NUMBER ONE
TO
AGREEMENT MA-060-13011271
BETWEEN THE
COUNTY OF ORANGE
AND
HL MILLER, INC.**

This AMENDMENT NUMBER ONE to Contract number MA-060-13011271 (hereinafter "AMENDMENT NUMBER ONE") between the County of Orange, a political subdivision of the State of California (hereinafter "COUNTY") and **HL Miller, Inc.** (hereinafter "CONTRACTOR") with a place of business at 2201 E. Winston Rd., Ste. I, Anaheim, CA 92806 is made and entered upon execution of all necessary signatures.

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR executed a Contract for General Construction and Maintenance Services, Contract number MA-060-13011271 (hereinafter "ORIGINAL AGREEMENT") for a ten (10) month term of March 19, 2013 through and including January 8, 2014, renewable for four (4) additional one (1) year terms; and,

WHEREAS, the County of Orange, CEO/Purchasing Services has issued a Regional Cooperative Agreement number MA-017-13010878 for this type of service; and

WHEREAS, COUNTY desires to renew the ORIGINAL AGREEMENT for a one (1) year term and the CONTRACTOR has agreed to continue providing these goods/services at the rates set forth in the ORIGINAL AGREEMENT;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual obligations set forth herein, both COUNTY and CONTRACTOR agree as follows:

1. **ARTICLES**

- a. Additional Terms and Conditions, Section **Term of Contract**, of the ORIGINAL AGREEMENT is amended to read in its entirety as follows:

1. **Term of Contract:**

This Contract shall commence upon execution of all necessary signatures, and continue in effect from 3/19/13 through and including 1/8/15, unless otherwise terminated by COUNTY. The period of 3/19/13 through and including 1/8/14 shall be known as Contract number MA-060-13011271. The period of 1/9/14 through and including 1/8/15 shall be known as Contract number MA-060-14010716. This Contract may be renewed for three (3) separate additional one-year terms by mutual written agreement of

both Parties and the renewal of Regional Cooperative Agreement number MA-017-13010878. The County is not under any obligation to provide Contractor with a reason should it elect not to renew this Contract, nor is the County obligated to provide any prior notice to Contractor of its intent not to renew the Contract.

2. A true and correct copy of the ORIGINAL AGREEMENT (Agreement MA-060-13011271) is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated by this reference.
3. All other provisions of the ORIGINAL AGREEMENT except as amended herein, remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

SUBORDINATE AGREEMENT

Subordinate Agreement No. MA-060-13011271 with HL Miller, Inc. is hereby issued pursuant to the terms and conditions of cooperative agreement MA-017-13010878 for General Construction and Maintenance Services.

This Agreement MA-060-13011271 is made and entered into upon execution of all necessary signatures between HL Miller, Inc., having its principal place of business at 2201 E. Winston RD, Ste. I, Anaheim, CA 92806 (referred as "Contractor"), and the County of Orange, Sheriff-Coroner Department, a political subdivision of the State of California, with a place of business at 320 N. Flower Street, Santa Ana, CA 92703 (referred to as "County") which are sometimes individually referred to as "Party" or collectively referred to as "Parties".

RECITALS

WHEREAS, County of Orange, Sheriff-Coroner Department desires to enter into a Subordinate Agreement for General Construction and Maintenance Services; and

WHEREAS, the County of Orange, County Executive Office has issued a Regional Cooperative Agreement MA-017-13010878, now in effect from January 9, 2013 through January 8, 2014; and

WHEREAS, Contractor is willing to provide the services specified in this Subordinate Agreement to the County of Orange, Sheriff-Coroner Department;

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties mutually agree:

1. **Scope of Agreement:** This Subordinate Agreement specifies the terms and conditions by which the County of Orange, Sheriff-Coroner Department will procure goods/services from the Contractor, hereinafter referred to as "Services" as more fully detailed in Attachment A, Cooperative Agreement.
2. **Term of Subordinate Agreement:** This Subordinate Agreement shall commence upon execution of all necessary signatures and shall continue through and including January 8, 2014, unless otherwise terminated by the County. This Contract may be renewed for four (4) additional one-year terms upon mutual agreement of both Parties and upon renewal of RCA MA-017-13010878.



SUBORDINATE AGREEMENT

3. **Compensation & Payment:** Contractor agrees to provide the goods/services as set forth in Attachment "A" Cooperative Agreement at the fixed rates specified in the RCA. The total cost of this Subordinate Agreement shall not exceed \$325,000.00/year.
4. **Invoicing:** Invoices are to be submitted to the County of Orange, Sheriff-Coroner Department Research & Development Division at 431 The City Drive South, Orange, CA. Vendor shall reference Subordinate Agreement MA-060-13011271 on invoices. Payment will be net 30 days after receipt of an invoice in a format acceptable to the County of Orange and verified and approved by the agency/department and subject to routine processing requirements. The responsibility for providing an acceptable invoice rests with the contractor.
5. **Scope of Work:** Services and projects may be performed within the categories and at the rates contained within Exhibit A. Authorization and direction must be obtained in writing on approved forms from County of Orange, Sheriff-Coroner Department Research & Development Division, Facilities Planning/Facilities Operations prior to commencement of any work performed under this Contract. However, each individual public works project as defined in Public Contract Code Section 22002 performed under this Contract shall not exceed \$45,000. Projects shall not be split intentionally to avoid bidding pursuant to the Public Contract Code.
6. **Prevailing Wage (Labor Code §1773):** Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1773 of the Labor Code of the state of California, the Contractor shall comply with the general prevailing rates of per diem wages and the general prevailing rates for holiday and overtime wages in this locality for each craft, classification, or type of worker needed to execute this Contract. The rates are available from the Director of the Department of Industrial Relations at the following website: <http://www.dir.ca.gov/dlsr/DPreWageDetermination.htm>. The Contractor shall post a copy of such wage rates at the job site and shall pay the adopted prevailing wage rates. The Contractor shall comply with the provisions of Sections 1775 and 1813 of the Labor Code.
