RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF ORANGE COUNTY, CALIFORNIA

On motion of Supervisor Spitzer duly seconded and carried, the following Resolution was adopted:

WHEREAS, section 4675.1 of the Revenue and Taxation Code of the State of California (all section references in this Resolution are to the California Revenue and Taxation Code) permits a board of supervisors, by resolution, to authorize any County officer to perform on behalf of such board any act required or authorized to be performed by it under section 4675 related to distribution of excess tax sale proceeds; and

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the County Treasurer-Tax Collector and County

Counsel that this Board of Supervisors authorize the Treasurer-Tax Collector to perform certain acts on
the Board's behalf as provided in Revenue and Taxation Code section 4675.1.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

- 1. Pursuant to section 4675.1, the Treasurer-Tax Collector is hereby authorized to perform on behalf of this Board of Supervisors the following specified acts required to be performed by said Board under section 4675:
 - A. Determine the information and proof necessary to establish a claimant's rights to all or any portion of tax sale excess proceeds as authorized by section 4675.
 - B. Establish a claimant's rights to all or any portion of tax sale excess proceeds as authorized by section 4675.
 - C. Order the distribution of excess proceeds to the parties who have claimed the excess proceeds in the order of priority as authorized by section 4675.

2. The Treasurer-Tax Collector shall forward proposed distributions of excess proceeds to County Counsel, and County Counsel will review as to legal requirements.

- 3. The Auditor-Controller shall:
 - A. Pay excess proceeds claims when payment is requested by the Treasurer-Tax Collector and the request is reviewed by County Counsel as to legal requirements.
 - B. Record each act performed pursuant to this authorization as required by section 4675.1.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any action or proceeding to review the decision of the Treasurer-Tax Collector shall be commenced within 90 days after the date of the decision of the Treasurer-Tax Collector.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Treasurer-Tax Collector is directed to prepare and present to this Board of Supervisors an annual report summarizing the excess proceeds claims paid during the prior year.
