CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE FOR THE

INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL FOR SCIENCE AND CULTURE

"ISSAC ORG INC"

The Political Reform Act, Government Code Sections 81000, et seq., requires state and local government agencies to adopt and promulgate Conflict of Interest Codes. The Fair Political Practices Commission has adopted a regulation (2 Cal. Code of Regs. Section 18730) which contains the terms of a standard Conflict of Interest Code, which may be incorporated by reference in an agency's code. After public notice and hearing it may be amended by the Fair Political Practices Commission to conform to amendments in the Political Reform Act. Therefore, the terms of 2 California Code of Regulations Section 18730 and any amendments to it duly adopted by the Fair Political Practices Commission are hereby incorporated by reference. This regulation and the attached Appendix designating officials and employees and establishing disclosure categories, shall constitute the Conflict of Interest Code of the International School for Science and Culture.

Designated employees shall file statements of economic interests with the ISSAC ORG INC Political Reform Act Filing Officer who will make the statements available for public inspection and reproduction (Government Code Section 81008).

Upon receipt of the statements of the Board Members, the ISSAC's Filing Officer/Filing Official shall make and retain a copy and forward the original of these statements to the Clerk of the Orange County Board of Supervisors as the Filing Officer for these designated positions.

Statements for all other designated employees will be retained by the ISSAC's Filing Officer.

All of the above positions are designated positions in Category 1.

Types of Economic Interest to be Reported:

A designated position in Category 1 must report all investments, business positions, interests in real property, and sources of income, including receipt of gifts, loans, and travel payments.
