**AMENDMENT NO. TWO  
FOR  
ACTION FOR SPENT FUEL SOLUTIONS NOW (ASFSN)  
MANAGEMENT SERVICES AT SAN ONOFRE NUCLEAR GENERATING STATION**

This AMENDMENT NUMBER TWO to Contract MA-017-22011093 is made and entered into as of the date fully executed by and between the County of Orange, a political subdivision of the State of California (“County”) and Southwest Strategies, LLC, a California limited liability corporation (“Contractor”), with County and Contractor sometimes individually referred to as “Party” or collectively referred to as “Parties”.

**RECITALS**

WHEREAS, on March 22, 2022, the Parties executed Contract MA-017-22011093 (“Contract”) for Action for Spent Fuel Solutions Now (ASFSN) Management Services at San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station (SONGS), effective March, 22, 2022 through March, 21, 2023, in the total not-to-exceed amount of \$100,000; and

WHEREAS, on March 9, 2023, Parties executed Amendment Number One to renew the Contract for an additional one-year term, effective March, 22, 2023, through March, 21, 2024, in the amount of \$100,000, for a cumulative total amount not to exceed \$200,000; and

WHEREAS, the Parties now desire to amend the Contract for two additional years effective March, 22, 2024, through March, 21, 2026, in the amount of \$100,000 per year, with a new total cumulative not-to-exceed amount of \$400,000; and,

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties agree as follows:

**AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT**

1. Paragraph 2.0 of the Contract shall be amended to read as follows:

**Term of Contract:** This Contract shall commence on March 22, 2022, and continue through March 21, 2026, unless otherwise terminated by County. County does not have to give a reason if it elects not to renew.

2. Paragraph A of Attachment B, Compensation for Services, shall be amended to read as follows:

**Compensation:** In accordance with the provisions of the General and Additional Terms and Conditions, and Scope of Work herein, Contractor will be paid \$8,333.33 monthly, for a maximum total contract amount not to exceed \$400,000 under this Contract.

Contractor agrees to accept the specified compensation as set forth in this Contract as full remuneration for performing all services and furnishing all staffing and materials required, for any reasonably unforeseen difficulties which may arise or be encountered in the execution of the services until acceptance, for risks connected with the services, and for performance by Contractor of all its duties and obligations hereunder. County has no obligation to pay any sum in excess of the total Contract amount unless authorized by an amendment in accordance with paragraphs C and P of the Contract’s General Terms and Conditions.







\* If the contracting party is a corporation, (2) two signatures are required: one (1) signature by the Chairman of the Board, the President or any Vice President; and one (1) signature by the Secretary, any Assistant Secretary, the Chief Financial Officer or any Assistant Treasurer. The signature of one person alone is sufficient to bind a corporation, as long as he or she holds corporate offices in each of the two categories described above.
