This AMENDMENT NUMBER ~~THREE~~FOUR to Contract Number MA-060-19010992 (hereinafter “AMENDMENT NUMBER ~~THREE~~FOUR”) between the County of Orange, a political subdivision of the State of California (hereinafter “COUNTY”) and Siemens Industry, Inc., (hereinafter “CONTRACTOR”) with a place of business at 7850 Collections Center Drive, Chicago, IL 60693, with COUNTY and CONTRACTOR sometimes referred to collectively as “Parties,” is made and entered upon execution of all necessary signatures.

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR executed a Contract for Energy Management System Hardware/Software Fume Hoods Maintenance Services on April 16, 2019 as Contract Number MA-060-19010992 (hereinafter “ORIGINAL CONTRACT”), for a one-year term of April 23, 2019 through and including April 22, 2020 in an amount not to exceed \$36,136, renewable for four (4) additional one-year terms; and

WHEREAS, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR renewed the ORIGINAL CONTRACT on April 22, 2020 as Contract Number MA-060-20011405 for a one-year term of April 23, 2020 through and including April 22, 2021, in an amount not to exceed \$36,136 (hereinafter “AMENDMENT NUMBER ONE”);

WHEREAS, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR renewed the ORIGINAL CONTRACT on April 23, 2021, for a one-year term of April 23, 2021 through and including April 22, 2022 in an amount not to exceed \$37,220 (hereinafter “AMENDMENT NUMBER TWO”);

WHEREAS, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR ~~desires to~~ renewed the ORIGINAL CONTRACT on April 18, 2022, for a one-year term of April 23, 2022 through and including April 22, 2023 in an amount not to exceed \$37,220 ~~and the CONTRACTOR has agreed to provide these goods/services at the rates set forth in the ORIGINAL CONTRACT;~~ (hereinafter “AMENDMENT NUMBER THREE”);

WHEREAS, COUNTY desires to renew the ORIGINAL CONTRACT for a one-year term of April 23, 2023 through and including April 22, 2024 in an amount not to exceed \$37,220 and the CONTRACTOR has agreed to provide these goods/services at the rates set forth in the ORIGINAL CONTRACT;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual obligations set forth herein, both COUNTY and CONTRACTOR agree as follows:

1. ARTICLES

- a. Additional Terms and Conditions, Section 2, Term of Contract, is amended to read in its entirety as follows:
2. Term of Contract: This Contract shall commence upon execution of all necessary signatures, and continue in effect from 4/23/19 through and including 4/22/23~~4~~, unless otherwise terminated by COUNTY. The period of 4/23/19 through and including 4/22/20 shall be known as Contract Number MA-060-19010992. The period of 4/23/20 through and including 4/22/23~~4~~ shall be known as Contract Number MA-060-20011405.
- b. Additional Terms and Conditions, Section 3, Renewals, of the ORIGINAL CONTRACT is amended in its entirety as follows:
3. Renewal: This Contract may **not** be renewed. ~~for one (1) additional one-year term by mutual written agreement of both Parties. The County is not under any obligation to provide Contractor with a reason should it elect not to renew this Contract, nor is the County obligated to provide any prior notice to Contractor of its intent not to renew the Contract.~~
2. A true and correct copy of the ORIGINAL CONTRACT is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated by this reference.
  3. A true and correct copy of the AMENDMENT NUMBER ONE is attached hereto as Exhibit B and incorporated by this reference.
  4. A true and correct copy of the AMENDMENT NUMBER TWO is attached hereto as Exhibit C and incorporated by this reference.
  5. A true and correct copy of the AMENDMENT NUMBER THREE is attached hereto as Exhibit D and incorporated by this reference.
  6. All other provisions of the ORIGINAL CONTRACT, AMENDMENT NUMBER ONE, AMENDMENT NUMBER TWO and AMENDMENT NUMBER ~~TWO~~THREE, except as amended herein and to the extent they are not inconsistent with this AMENDMENT NUMBER ~~THREE~~FOUR, remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
