AMENDMENT NUMBER TWO TO CONTRACT MA-060-20011744 BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF ORANGE AND

This AMENDMENT NUMBER TWO to Contract Number MA-060-20011744 (hereinafter "AMENDMENT NUMBER TWO") between the County of Orange, a political subdivision of the State of California, operating through its Sheriff-Coroner Department (hereinafter "COUNTY"), and SF Mobile-Vision, Inc. DBA COBAN Technologies, Inc/Safe Fleet Law Enforcement, (hereinafter referred to as "CONTRACTOR") with a place of business at 400 Commons Way, Suite F, Rockway, NJ. 07866 is made and entered upon execution of all necessary signatures.

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR executed a Contract for Digital In-Car Police Video Systems and Software Solution Maintenance on June 23, 2020, for a one (1) year term of June 24, 2020 through and including June 23, 2021, in an amount not to exceed \$61,319.77 renewable for four (4) additional one (1) year terms (hereinafter "ORIGINAL CONTRACT");

WHEREAS, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR renewed the ORIGINAL CONTRACT on April 21, 2021, for a one (1) year term of June 24, 2021 through and including June 23, 2022, in amount not to exceed \$61,319.77 renewable for three (3) additional one (1) year terms (hereinafter "AMENDMENT NUMBER ONE");

WHEREAS, COUNTY desires to renew the ORIGINAL CONTRACT for a one (1) year term of June 24, 2022 through and including June 23, 2023 in an amount not to exceed \$61,319.77, renewable for two (2) additional one (1) year terms, and the CONTRACTOR has agreed to continue to provide those services at the rates set forth in the ORIGINAL CONTRACT;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual obligations set forth herein, both COUNTY and CONTRACTOR agree as follows:

1. <u>ARTICLES</u>

- a. Additional Terms and Conditions, Section Term of Contract, of the ORIGINAL CONTRACT is amended to read in its entirety as follows:
 - 2. Term of Contract:

This Contract shall commence upon execution of all necessary signatures, and continue in effect from 6/24/20 through and including 6/23/23, unless otherwise terminated by COUNTY.

b. Additional Terms and Conditions, Section 3 – Renewal, of the ORIGINAL CONTRACT is amended in its entirety as follows:

- 3. Renewal: This Contract may be renewed by mutual written agreement of both parties for two (2) additional one (1) year terms. The County does not have to give reason if it elects not to renew. Renewal periods maybe subject to approval by the County of Orange Board of Supervisors.
- c. ATTACHMENT B, Compensation and Pricing Provisions, Section 2, Fees and Charges of the ORIGINAL CONTRACT is amended in its entirety to read as follows:
 - 2. Fees and Charges: County will pay the following fees in accordance with the provisions of this Contract. Payment shall be as follows:
