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**CONTRACT OPERATING EXPENSES**

The maximum funding obligation of COUNTY under this Agreement shall not exceed the amount of \$8,00,000, or actual allowable costs, whichever is less. The estimated annual amount for each twelve (12) month period is as follows:

- \$1,600,000 for July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2022;
- \$1,600,000 for July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023;
- \$1,600,000 for July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024;
- \$1,600,000 for July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025; and
- \$1,600,000 for July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.
