Subject: Addition of Supplemental Item to the June 4, 2024 Board Meeting Agenda

Supervisor Vicente Sarmiento requests to add a supplemental agenda item to the June 4, 2024 Board of Supervisors meeting.

1. Approve the use of \$100,000 from Second District’s Budget Control 007, to fund the University of California, Irvine to conduct the first portion of the evaluation of the Homeless Prevention and Stabilization Program.
2. Direct the Auditor-Controller, in accordance with Government Code Section 29125, to adjust appropriations and revenue in the Board of Supervisors – Second District, Budget Control 007, and County Strategic Planning and Board Initiatives, Fund 12N, as identified by Second District and as detailed below. **(Requires four-fifths vote.)**

3. Find that under Government Code section 26227 these expenditures are necessary to meet the social needs of the population of the county, including but not limited to, the areas of health, law enforcement, public safety, rehabilitation, welfare, education, and legal services, and the needs of physically, mentally and financially handicapped persons and aged persons.
4. Authorize County Executive Officer, or designee, to negotiate and enter into agreements as necessary to effectuate the purposes of this allocation, including but not limited to, the execution of agreements with fund recipient, as identified by the Second District Supervisor.

5. Authorize and direct the Auditor-Controller, or designee, to make related payments as necessary to effectuate the purposes of this allocation, including, but not limited to Cal-Card, electronic fund transfers or check payments.

On January 9, 2024, the Board of Supervisors approved funds to support the Homeless Prevention and Stabilization Program (Program). A critical component of the Program is an eighteen-month evaluation study which will measure the Program's effectiveness in maintaining housing stability for individuals that are on the brink of homelessness. The evaluation component is currently unfunded, and the use of Second District funds will allow the University of California, Irvine to conduct the first phase of the study. Second District is working to secure additional sources of funding to complete the remaining phases of the study.
