Ratify Subordinate Contracts for the provision of Domestic Violence Shelter Program Services with Human Options, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$50,000 for the period of January 1, 2022, through June 30, 2022; Interval House, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$60,000 for the period of January 1, 2022 through June 30, 2022; Laura's House, in an amount not to exceed \$50,000 for the period January 1, 2022 through June 30, 2022; and Women's Transitional Living Center, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$50,000, for the period of January 1, 2022, through June 30, 2022, unless otherwise terminated by the County.

SUMMARY:

Ratification and approval of Subordinate Domestic Violence Shelter-Based Program contracts with selected providers will support the continued provision of services for the victims of domestic violence and other crimes.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

In March 2016, the Governor's Office of Emergency Services (Cal-OES) announced a new grant opportunity to address gaps or needs for services specific for the County Victim Services Program. The program began as a one-time grant opportunity that required a mandated Steering Committee consisting of representatives from specific areas and Cal-OES funded victim service providers including the Social Services Agency, Health Care Agency, OC Probation, Sheriff-Coroner Department, Courts, and Cal-OES funded community-based organizations providing services to victims of crime. Existing contracts with OC Community Resources (OCCR) have been used to facilitate the delivery of services with the intent of the grant addressing gaps in existing services.

Under the direction of the Steering Committee, grant funds were identified to meet the gaps in services provided by the County's providers for crime victim services and domestic violence services that include crisis response coordination, increased access to in-house emergency legal and criminal justice advocacy, increased emergency housing assistance and enhanced mental health services.

The County Executive Office has managed the County Victim Services grant program, which has continued annually since implementation utilizing contracts managed by OCCR. As such, the multiple amendments of the existing contracts have hindered the ability to properly plan and implement the objectives of the grant. The funding awarded is by calendar year requiring multiple amendments to the existing fiscal year contracts causing additional work for OCCR. To better manage the grant, CEO is requesting ratification of subordinate contracts from January 1, 2022 to June 30, 2022 to align with the grant period. Furthermore, the processing of payments across the departments is also not consistent risking the delay of payments.

The County Executive Office is requesting ratification and approval of Subordinate Contracts to those utilized by OCCR which designate providers for domestic violence services as determined through a competitive bidding process compliant with the County's Contract Policy Manual. The terms of the contracts are in line with the existing contracts and begin on January 1, 2022, to align with the current grant award as outlined below:

Services provided by Human Options, Inc., Laura's House, Interval House, and Women's Transitional Living Center, Inc. (WTLC) have been satisfactory.

No subcontractors have been identified.

The proposed contracts are subordinate to the master agreements issued by OCCR and the Orange County Preference Policy (OCPP) was applicable and incorporated into this solicitation with one award made to an OCPP qualified vendor under the Local Small Business (LSB) preference policy receiving a five percent advantage.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

Appropriations for these Subordinate Contracts are included in the County Executive Office, Budget Control 017, FY 2021-22 Budget. The Contracts contain language allowing County Executive Office to terminate the contracts or reduce the level of services without penalty with or without cause in the event that funding is reduced and/or not available to continue funding the Contracts.

ATTACHMENT B - SCOPE OF WORK

I. DOMESTIC VIOLENCE COUNTY VICTIM SERVICES

1. On March 1, 2016, Cal OES issued a Request for Application for a new County Victim Services Program to provide one-time, federal VOCA funding to help fill victim services gaps and or needs over the period of July 1, 2016 to June 30, 2018. The grant required a Steering Committee be established with mandatory representation from several County departments, specific Cal OES funded projects, courts, and local law enforcement. The Committee collaboratively identified several existing gaps and needs with services provided to the County's crime victims and approved several projects to meet their needs to be facilitated through an expansion of county and contracted services.

The County Executive Office manages the Cal OES grant and amendments were made to the existing contracts in place with OC Community Resources. The Cal OES grant program has continued on an annual basis with varying funding amounts and the prioritization of the use of funding being determined by the Steering Committee. This subordinate agreement is established to provide the County Executive Office the means to properly manage the grant award and align the funding with the agreed upon plan as determined by the Steering Committee.

2. Purpose:

- a. Provide assistance with Criminal Justice and other legal proceedings, improve access for crime victims who are elderly, have transportation issues, special needs, or those who cannot access services during normal working hours by:
 - i. Increase access for in-house emergency legal and criminal justice advocacy
 - ii. Provide accompaniment for domestic violence victims coming into the shelter and walk-in centers.

b. Emergency Housing Assistance

- i. Provide additional shelter bed nights, emergency hotel vouchers, food and/or transportation for domestic violence victims.
- ii. Make needed repairs and/or upgrades to existing shelter to allow for increased capacity.
- c. Enhanced Mental Health Services. Address demand for mental health services for adult and youth victims of domestic violence and increase capacity to offer services in additional languages to culturally underserved victims.
 - i. Expand individual and group counseling and therapy for adult and youth victims of domestic violence
 - ii. Increase capacity to offer counseling and mental health services to culturally underserved domestic violence victims
 - iii. Increase the number of sessions and/or locations to meet the demand that exists.
