AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO CONTRACT MA-080-21010471 FOR ON-CALL BRIDGE DESIGN SERVICES

This Amendment is made and entered into as of the date fully executed by and between the County of Orange, a political subdivision of the State of California ("County"), and Biggs Cardosa Associates, Inc., a California Corporation ("A-E"), with County and A-E sometimes individually referred to as "Party" or collectively referred to as "Parties."

RECITALS

WHEREAS, County and A-E entered into Contract MA-080-21010471 for On-Call Bridge Design Services, effective December 15, 2020 to December 14, 2023, in an amount not-to-exceed One Million Five Hundred Thousand dollars \$1,500,000 (the "Contract"); and,

WHEREAS, the Parties wish to add the Orange County Flood Control District ("District") as a Party; and,

WHEREAS, the Parties now desire to renew the term of the Contract for two (2) years, with a maximum allowable compensation of Five Hundred Thousand dollars (\$500,000) effective December 15, 2023 to December 14, 2025; and,

WHEREAS, the Parties now desire to update the notice provision; and,

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties agree as follows:

ARTICLES

- 1. The Orange County Flood Control District shall be added as a Party to the Contract. A-E shall indemnify the District in the same manner as it does the County. A-E shall name District as an Additional Insured in the same manner County is under Section 3.1.4(C)(1)(a). A-E's Worker's Compensation policy shall contain a waiver of subrogation endorsement waiving all rights of subrogation against District in the same manner as against County under Section 3.1.4(C)(2). A-E's insurance policies shall waive all rights of subrogation against District in the same manner as against County under Section 3.1.4(C)(2).
- 2. The following shall be added to the Recitals:

WHEREAS, the District relies on County staff to carry out its duties pursuant to the Orange County Flood Control District Act, Water Code App. §§ 36-1 et seq., and County staff may request A-E to perform services under this Contract on behalf of District; and,

3. Article 1.4. shall be amended to read in its entirety as follows:

This Contract is renewed for two (2) years, effective December 15, 2023 to December 14, 2025, with a maximum allowable compensation of Five Hundred Thousand dollars (\$500,000), except as permitted in Paragraph 1.5 below.

4. Article 6.14.3 shall be amended to include the following:

All communications shall be addressed to the appropriate party at the address stated herein or such other address as the parties hereto may designate by written notice from time to time in the manner aforesaid.
