

**AMENDMENT NO. 1
TO CONTRACT MA-080-21010543
FOR
ON-CALL REGULATORY PERMITTING AND RESTORATION SERVICES**

This Amendment is made and entered into as of the date fully executed by and between the County of Orange, a political subdivision of the State of California ("County"), and AECOM Technical Services, Inc. ("A-E"), with County and A-E sometimes individually referred to as "Party" or collectively referred to as "Parties."

RECITALS

WHEREAS, County and A-E entered into Contract MA-080-21010543 for On-Call Regulatory Permitting and Restoration Services, effective December 15, 2020 through December 14, 2023, in —a maximum allowable compensation of \$1,500,000 (the "Contract"); and,

WHEREAS, the Parties wish to add the Orange County Flood Control District ("District") as a Party; and,

WHEREAS, Parties now desire to renew the term of the Contract for two (2) additional years, effective December 15, 2023, to December 14, 2025, with a maximum allowable compensation of One Million Five Hundred Thousand dollars (\$1,500,000); and

WHEREAS, Parties now desire to amend the Contract Notices; and

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties mutually agree as follows:

ARTICLES

1. The Orange County Flood Control District shall be added as a Party to the Contract. A-E shall indemnify the District in the same manner as it does the County. A-E shall name District as an Additional Insured in the same manner County is under Section 3.1.4(C)(1)(a). A-E's Worker's Compensation policy shall contain a waiver of subrogation endorsement waiving all rights of subrogation against District in the same manner as against County under Section 3.1.4(C)(2). A-E's insurance policies shall waive all rights of subrogation against District in the same manner as against County under Section 3.1.4(C)(3).
2. The following shall be added to the Recitals:

WHEREAS, the District relies on County staff to carry out its duties pursuant to the Orange County Flood Control District Act, Water Code App. §§ 36-1 et seq., and County staff may request A-E to perform services under this Contract on behalf of District; and,

3. Article 1.4. shall be amended to read as follows:

The term of this Contract is renewed for two (2) years, with Board of Supervisor approval, effective December 15, 2023, through December 14, 2025, with a maximum allowable compensation of One Million Five Hundred Thousand dollars (\$1,500,000), except as permitted in Paragraph 1.5.

B. Initial Term Contract Amount Shall Not Exceed:	<u>\$1,500,000</u>
Renewal Term Contract Amount Shall Not Exceed:	<u>\$1,500,000</u>

6. All other terms and conditions of the Contract shall remain unchanged and with full force and effect.
