

## Amendment Number Three to Contract with Mercer Health & Benefits LLC, for Provision of Employee Benefits Consulting and Actuarial Services

THIS AMENDMENT Number Three (hereinafter "Amendment"), is made and entered into, upon execution of all necessary signatures, by and between the County of Orange, a political subdivision of the State of California (hereinafter "County"), and Mercer Health & Benefits LLC, with a place of business at 17901 Von Karman Avenue, Suite 1100, Irvine CA 92614, (hereinafter "Contractor"), which are sometimes individually referred to as "Party" or collectively referred to as "Parties".

WHEREAS, County and Contractor executed Contract for Provision of Employee Benefits Consulting and Actuarial Services, effective December 8, 2016 through December 7, 2019 (hereinafter "Contract"); and

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into Amendment Number One of the Contract to renew the Contract for one (1) additional year from December 8, 2019 to December 7, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into Amendment Number Two of the Contract to renew the Contract for one (1) additional year from December 8, 2020 to December 7, 2021; and

WHEREAS, both Parties desire to extend the Contract through December 31, 2021 and amend Attachments A and B of the Contract;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual obligations set forth herein, both County and Contractor agree as follows:

- 1. Pursuant to Article 4 of the Contract, the Contract is hereby extended through December 31, 2021.
- 2. Attachment A Scope of Work, Section II is hereby amended to include:

## g. Communication Projects:

- 1. Contractor shall assist the County with ad-hoc communication projects on an as needed basis, subject to and at the direction of the County.
- 2. For any project requested by the County, Contractor shall first conduct a discovery session to understand County needs, requirements, audience, number of versions, and method of delivery.
- 3. Based on the discovery session, Contractor shall provide a Statement of Work to the County. The Statement of Work outlines the communication to be prepared, costs, and expected timing. Contractor requires a signature of the Statement of Work before beginning any work.
- 4. Contractor shall provide writing, editing, communication peer review, graphic design and layout, and project management services.
- 5. Contractor shall draft language and provide:

- a. One draft in a text version to the County to review and provide feedback.
- b. One draft in layout with pictures, graphics, and text.
- c. One final draft for approval.
- 6. Contractor shall provide one version of each communication, unless otherwise specified.
- 7. For foreseen problems, Contractor will build time into the project plan to avoid extra drafts wherever possible. For unforeseen changes, Contractor will charge for additional rounds of review depending on the hours required to make updates. Contractor will provide an estimate of time required upfront and charge time on an hourly basis using the applicable hourly rates specified in Attachment B.
- 8. Upon approval by the County, Contractor shall provide final files for printing, posting, and distribution at the County's discretion.
- 9. Contractor shall not be responsible for printing, mailing, translation, or distribution of communication materials.
- 10. The following are agreed upon fees for the specified communication documents. For any communication projects not specified below, County and Contractor shall come to a mutual agreement on fees prior to commencement of any work.
